Registration Fee (Preschool-Gr. 8): \$300 per Family is applicable to total tuition and NON REFUNDABLE

- One deposit covers Preschool - Gr. 8 but Preschool and K-8 tuition remain separate and will be added together to produce the **total tuition** due.
- Registration Fee is \$300 per Family **by** Thursday, March 5, 2026 and is applicable to total tuition and **Non Refundable**.
- Starting March 9, 2026 the Family Registration Fee is \$500 per Family and is applicable to total tuition and **Non Refundable**.
- A Completed Tuition Contract will be needed along with Registration Fee.

Is there anything I can do to reduce the cost of my tuition?

- **Apply for \$150 Alumni Grant** for parents who are SJA Alumni. Contact the school office.
- **Apply for the Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Grant** based on financial need. Details and applications are available in the school office, on our website - stjoan.net and the AOD website - <https://www.detroitcatholicschools.org/tuition-assistance-scholarships>
- **Use the school’s Raise Right Program.** Buy gift cards at face value for shopping, groceries, and numerous other stores and receive a rebate on tuition. **Families receive 100% of Raise Right credit.**
- **Apply for our Family Scholarship (late fall).** SJA Parish membership required. This one-time grant is available for families with unexpected financial difficulty. If the request is being made within the time frame of the Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Grant process, the family must also have applied for the Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Grant.

Payment Options:

- The Blackbaud Smart Tuition administrative fee of \$56 is applied on the first payment unless you are a 1 or 2 month payment plan. Then the school will absorb the fee.
- Tuition paid in full by June 30, 2026 to SJA Parish or School office or through Smart is discounted 2%.
- Tuition accounts on the 2 payment plan are due August 2026 & January 2027 to SJA through Smart.
- Tuition accounts on the 10, 11 or 12 monthly payment plan begin in June and are due on the 5th, 15th, 20th or 30th of each month per the selected plan through Blackbaud Smart Tuition.
- A **\$65 Late Fee** will apply to any payment not paid by the due date *or* any outstanding balance.
