HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE TO THE ARCHDIOCESE OF HARTFORD

If you have knowledge or suspect that a minor or vulnerable adult (an adult with an intellectual disability) has been sexually abused, in any manner, by personnel of the Archdiocese of Hartford, you are urged to report this information to:

In addition, you will be asked to follow up in writing with a detailed description of the facts involved in the incident. Specifics of this written report can be found in the <u>Policies and Procedures of the Archdiocese of Hartford Relating to Allegations of Sexual Misconduct Involving Minors and Vulnerable Adults</u>. This document is also available online at <u>www.archdioceseofhartford.org</u>. The Archdiocese of Hartford will report any and all incidents to the proper civil authorities.

Mandated reporters in the State of Connecticut are required by law to report any incident of sexual abuse involving a minor or vulnerable adult. We encourage any Non-Mandated persons to report such incidents to the proper authorities as well. We support your right to do so.

Incidents involving sexual abuse of minors (persons under the age of 18) should be reported to:

Incidents involving sexual abuse of vulnerable adults aged 18 – 59 should be reported to the:

Connecticut Department of Developmental Services – AID Division for Persons with Intellectual Disabilities

Department of Social Services for the Elderly

Once a written report of an incident of sexual abuse of a minor or vulnerable adult has been received, an investigation will be undertaken by, or on behalf of, the Archdiocese of Hartford.

Parish Update

Parish Office: The Parish Office will be open Monday-Thursday, from 10:00AM to 2:00 PM.

Baptisms: We are celebrating Baptisms again. They may take place on any Sunday at 12:30 PM, one family at a time, with a maximum of 20 people in attendance.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation: Confessions will be heard, beginning this Saturday, June 13, 3:00 to 4:00 PM. They will be heard in the main body of the church in the south wing (rectory side) with special precautions. You should wait for confession in the north wing (Magowan Center side) when someone else is confessing. After they have confessed, you may come to the south wing where you will see that a screen has been set in place.

Funerals: Funerals with Mass in Church will resume on June 8th. The number of people who may attend a funeral is limited at the present time to 90 persons. When this changes, we will notify you.

First Holy Communion: First Holy Communion will be held on Saturday, June 20, at 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM, and on Saturday, June 27, at 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM.

Confirmation: Father Matera has written for permission to perform Confirmation on two Saturdays, one in September and the other in early October. There will be two Confirmation ceremonies on each day for the sake of social distancing.

Website: Please consult our website, which is updated daily. You will find a video about the opening of the church as well as videos of daily and Sunday Mass.

Streaming Fund: We are investing in equipment that will allow us to stream our services more easily and regularly. If you would like to contribute to this fund, send your donation to the Parish Office, with a check made out to "St. Mary's Church." Write "streaming" in the notation.

Visit the Church: The church is open every day from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM for prayer and visitation. Please enter through the Magowan Center.

Do You Need Help? These are difficult days for many people. Some have lost jobs and are struggling to pay bills. Others are finding it difficult to cope with the isolation caused by this pandemic. If you need help, please contact Father Matera. Parishioners have given us food cards that will be of assistance to you. There is also a parish charities account that is intended to assist those in need. Finally, if you wish, our Stephen Ministers will gladly speak with you and accompany you during this difficult period.

A Seamless Transition to Distance Learning Ensures Continued Student Success

With the closure of schools in March, St. Mary's School faculty, students and families didn't miss a beat, diving into distance learning, from Zoom to Loom, Flipgrid to Google Classroom. As a 1:1 iPad school, every child, grades K thru 8 was able to quickly engage in this "new normal" of learning with teachers and classmates. This, along with teachers continuing to provide physical work packets and hands on projects, has created a consistent balance of meeting the needs of all our students.

Small class size has allowed for teachers to meet individually with students on a weekly basis, as well as conference with parents, even having some fun with talent and pet shows.
