A Change of Parish Trustee: This January, I appointed Thomas Rechen as Parish Trustee. Tom will succeed Rick Lenz who has been a Trustee for more than twenty years. In addition to being members of the Corporation, their role is to provide the Pastor with the necessary counsel for the administration of the parish.

A Tribute to Rick Lenz: Many of you know Rick Lenz as a long time parishioner who, with his wife Fay, has been deeply involved in the life of our Parish and School. When I was appointed Pastor of St. Mary's Church in 2012, Rick was the first person from St. Mary's to contact and welcome me. Ever since, he has been a stalwart support and a good friend. Fast and Abstinence

Fasting: Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting for all Catholics between the ages of 14 and 59. On this day, Catholics should fast by eating only one main meal and two lesser meals that do not equal the main meal. They should also refrain from eating between meals.

Abstinence: The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence from eating meat for all Catholics who are 14 or older.

This Wednesday, February 17, is the beginning of Lent. Nearly a year ago, churches and schools were closed because of the pandemic, and ever since we have been enduring a Lent forced upon us by this pandemic. We have been socially distancing from each other, and we have refrained from parties and social gatherings. And so, you might be asking, "What need is there for another Lent? We have been observing Lent for a whole year!"

There is truth in that statement. This past year has seemed like an eternal Lent. But the experience of this past year has also shown us our deep need for repentance and prayer. The pandemic has revealed the fissures in our society that need to be healed. It has shown us how much we have taken for granted. It has shown our need for a deeper union with each other *in Christ* so that can truly be one in the body of Christ.

How should we approach Lent? The traditional are almsgiving, prayer, and fasting. We need to observe these three penitential practices more than ever: (1) sharing our resources with others, (2) praying more earnestly, (3) fasting and abstaining from food and drink so that our minds will be more focused on God.

During this Lenten Season, St. Mary's offers many ways to grow in the life of Christ.
