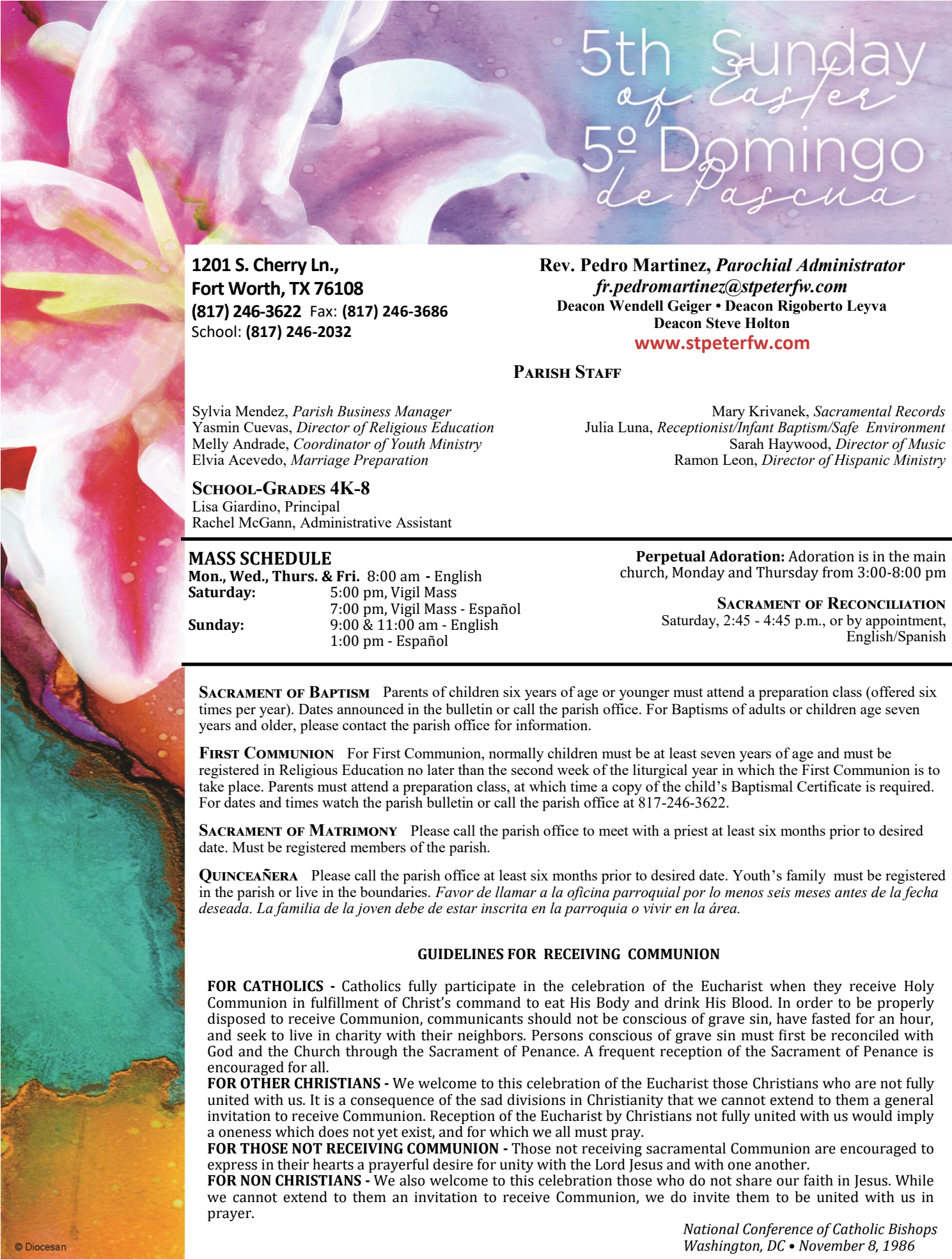

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM Parents of children six years of age or younger must attend a preparation class (offered six times per year). Dates announced in the bulletin or call the parish office. For Baptisms of adults or children age seven years and older, please contact the parish office for information.

FIRST COMMUNION For First Communion, normally children must be at least seven years of age and must be registered in Religious Education no later than the second week of the liturgical year in which the First Communion is to take place. Parents must attend a preparation class, at which time a copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate is required. For dates and times watch the parish bulletin or call the parish office at 817-246-3622.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY Please call the parish office to meet with a priest at least six months prior to desired date. Must be registered members of the parish.

QUINCEAÑERA Please call the parish office at least six months prior to desired date. Youth's family must be registered in the parish or live in the boundaries. *Favor de llamar a la oficina parroquial por lo menos seis meses antes de la fecha deseada. GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION

FOR CATHOLICS - Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's command to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for an hour, and seek to live in charity with their neighbors. Persons conscious of grave sin must first be reconciled with God and the Church through the Sacrament of Penance. A frequent reception of the Sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

FOR OTHER CHRISTIANS - We welcome to this celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive Communion. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we all must pray.

FOR THOSE NOT RECEIVING COMMUNION - Those not receiving sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with the Lord Jesus and with one another.

FOR NON CHRISTIANS - We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus. While we cannot extend to them an invitation to receive Communion, we do invite them to be united with us in prayer.

El miércoles 21 de abril del 2021, nos notificaron que el condado de Tarrant ha alcanzado el índice del 75% de la población que ha tenido COVID y/o han recibido 1 o 2 dosis de la vacuna. Para la Misa ahora estamos pidiendo a las personas / familias que decidan el nivel individual de protección con el que se sientan cómodos ya que no es requerido el uso de cubre bocas. Si usted está más cómodo usando un cubre bocas, entonces por favor continúe haciéndolo. Además, la Sagrada Comunión se puede dar en la lengua o en la mano, en cualquier modo que usted elija. Los protocolos de distanciamiento social de una distancia física de 3 pies entre familias y/o individuos siguen vigentes. Seguimos desinfectando todas las instalaciones parroquiales. Si hay un aumento del 20% en los nuevos casos de COVID, entonces se restablecerá el requisito de cubre bocas. Por favor, tengan paciencia y comprensión entre sí en esta transición. La escuela va a notificar a los padres y estudiantes si hay algún cambio en sus protocolos de COVID.

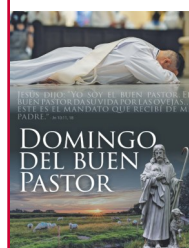

Parishioners of Saint Peter the Apostle Catholic Church,
On Wednesday, April 21, 2021, we were notified that Tarrant County has reached the 75% threshold of the population who have had COVID and/or have received 1 or 2 doses of the vaccine. For Mass we are now asking individuals/families to take the individual level of protection they are comfortable with by **no longer requiring all to wear a face mask. If you are more comfortable wearing a mask, then please continue to do so. In addition, Holy Communion can be given on the tongue or the hand, should one choose to receive so accordingly.** Social distancing protocols of a physical distance of 3 feet between families and/or individuals are still in place. We continue sanitizing all parish facilities. If there is an increase of 20% in new COVID cases, then the mask requirement will be reinstated. Please be patient and understanding with one another in this transition. The school is going to notify parents and students if there are any changes in their COVID protocols.

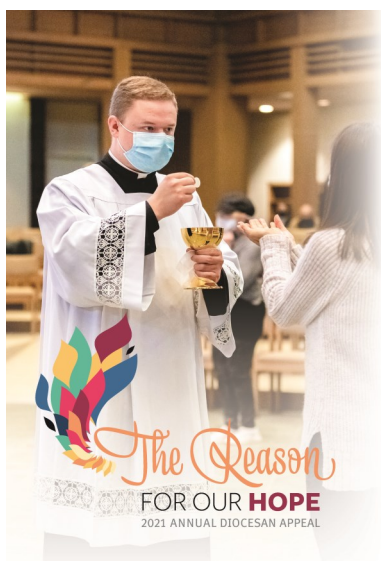

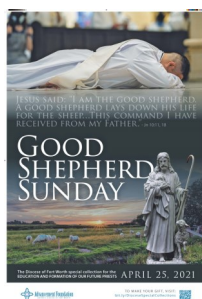
