We welcome those Parents and Godparents wishing to Baptize a child at St. Peter the Apostle Church. Our Baptism classes are held in both English and Spanish. There is no fee for this class.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARENTS

- ❖ A member of St. Peter's parish or live in our boundaries.
- Choose two Godparents, one man, one woman. (One Godparent is acceptable; you do not need to have two.)
- Attend a Baptism preparation class.

REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS

- Godparents must be at least 18 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, attend Mass weekly and receive Holy Communion regularly.
- ❖ Godparents must be living a life consistent with the Catholic faith; may not be living together in a relationship outside of a Catholic marriage.
- ❖ If married, Godparents must have received the Sacrament of *Matrimony in the Catholic Church*.
- ❖ A Godparent must be an active, registered member of a Catholic Parish.
- Attend a Baptism preparation class.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED BEFORE SCHEDULING A BAPTISM

- ❖ A copy of your child's birth certificate.
- ❖ A copy of your Godparent's Confirmation certificate, if single.
- ❖ A copy of your Godparents' Catholic marriage certificate, if married.
- ❖ If out of boundaries, Parents and Godparents must present a letter of permission from their parish giving permission to baptize at St. Peter.
