Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time

Part XXVIII:

"The Lord, the giver of life"

Two main points stand out in this particular line of the Creed. Think about this first point for a moment: the Lord. How often do we hear the phrase "The Lord", and how often is it associated with anyone but Jesus? Seldom. With the exception of the Old Testament, the phrase "the Lord" applies almost exclusively to Jesus who is our Lord and God. But in this line the writers of the Creed made two point for us in two words: the Holy Spirit is equal to the other two person of God and the title "Lord" applies equally to the Spirit as to the Son and Father.



The second point is in relation to the Holy Spirit's abilities. We know that God created the world and everything in the Universe. In the eleventh line of the Creed it states that Jesus also created all things. Reiterating an earlier but incredibly important point: whatever can be attributed to one person of God can be attributed to all the persons of God. Therefore the Holy Spirit is not outside the bounds of the creative power of God but equally a co-creator with the other two persons. Yet this line does not emphasize the same point as the other two. Instead of stating that he created the

world, it states that he is the "giver of life." We can only hypothesize the extent of what this line entails. On one end, the Holy Spirit overshadowed Mary and thus impregnated her with God. On the other end, the Spirit gives life just as the Father and Son did in creating the universe.


