For the St. Anthony's there were 4 trays of pastries, cookies, Brownies, cakes. Prom will be on April 24th. The sign-up genius does not work.
- Audra Launey has set another date for another bake sale at St. Ignatius. April
 14th, 2023. That is for the SPA general account.
- Volleyball Tailgate \$419.33 and we earned \$204.75. Thankful to St. Ignatius for donations, to the parent volunteers and those who helped. We have a SPA budget of \$3,300. We have \$758.00 from athletic concessions. We have sold \$2,395.73 but have spent \$1,637.59.
- We spent \$350 dollars for the homecoming DJ.
- UT Concession \$2,242.61-\$339.41= \$1,903.20 With that money, we have the prom funds.
