


Jan. 4, 2026 Epiphany	 <b>Mass/Class</b> Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. <b>Christ in Us, Pg 43: Unit 1, Lesson 4 – Who is Jesus Christ?</b> <b>Theme:</b> Mary is the mother of Jesus. Jesus, Mary and Joseph are the Holy Family. On January 1, the Church celebrated the <b>Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God</b> . <b>Gospel Weekly Theme:</b> Jesus is the Son of God (Epiphany/Magi's visit). Matthew 2:1-12
Jan. 11 Baptism of Lord	 <b>Mass/Class</b> Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. <b>Christ in Us, Pg 77: Unit 2, Lesson 8 – How do We Become Members of the Church?</b> <b>Theme:</b> Baptism welcomes us into the Church. We are children of God. At Baptism we become one with Jesus. <b>Gospel Weekly Theme:</b> We are Baptized into God's Family. God is Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Matthew 3:13-17)
Jan. 18	 <b>Mass only – (MLK weekend – No Lessons today)</b>
Jan. 25	 <b>Mass/Class</b> Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. <b>Christ in Us, Pg 51: Unit 1, Lesson 5 – What is the Church?</b> <b>Theme:</b> The Church is the family of God.
