

Dec. 14-3 <sup>rd</sup> Sun Advent	 <b>Family Faith</b> K-HS Families attend any Sunday Mass & arrive 10 minutes before Mass for Mass lesson. <b>Christmas Pageant</b> Will Take Place in Church after the 12 noon Mass (~1:15 pm)
Dec. 21-4 <sup>th</sup> Sun Advent	 Mass Only

Jan. 4, 2026 Epiphany	 <b>Mass/Class</b> Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. <b>Christ in Us, Pg. 43: Unit 1, Lesson 4 – Who is Jesus Christ?</b> <b>Theme:</b> God chose Mary to be the mother of Jesus. Jesus is God's only Son. Jesus gives new life. On January 1, the Church celebrated the <b>Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God</b> . <b>Gospel Weekly Theme:</b> Jesus is Born to Save all People (Epiphany – Magi's visit – Matthew 2:1-12).

4/19	 <b>Mass/Class</b> Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson.
