

Jan. 4, 2026 Epiphany	✙ Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 43: Unit 1, Lesson 4 – Who is Jesus Christ? Theme: God chose Mary to be the mother of Jesus. Jesus is God's only Son. Jesus gives new life. On January 1, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. Gospel Weekly Theme: Jesus is Born to Save all People (Epiphany – Magi's visit – Matthew 2:1-12).
Jan. 11 Baptism of Lord Parents invited.	✙ Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 77: Unit 2, Lesson 8 - How Do We Become Members of the Church? Theme: The Sacraments of Christian Initiation join us to Christ and his Church. Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Gospel Weekly Theme: We Belong to God's Family (Matthew 3:13-17)

Confessions Lent	✚ Family Faith Come to Confession during Lent. Confessions will be offered on Monday evenings during Lent. Confessions are always available on Saturdays from 4:00-5:00 pm
Feb. 22 – 1 st Sun Lent	✚ Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 119: Unit 3, Lesson 13 – How Does God Teach Us to Love? Theme: The Ten Commandments guide our relationship with God and with others. Gospel Weekly Theme: Lent Calls Us to Choose God (Matthew 4:4-11)
March 1 – 2 nd Sun Lent	✚ Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 85: Unit 2, Lesson 9 – How do We Celebrate God's Forgiveness & Healing? Theme: The Sacrament of Penance. The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Lent is here and this is a good time to review the Act of Contrition to prepare for Confession. Gospel Weekly Theme: God Tells Us to Listen to Jesus (Matthew 17:1-9)
3/8 – 3 rd Sun Lent	✚ Family Faith K-HS Families attend 8 am, 10 am Mass & arrive 10 minutes before Mass for Mass lesson. Stay in church after Mass for a 30-minute Eucharistic Adoration lesson w/Fr. Richard
3/15 – 4 th Sun Lent	✚ Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 211: Unit 5, Lesson 25 Triduum Theme: Triduum - During Holy Week, we celebrate the three days of the Triduum. Gospel Weekly Theme: We Believe in Jesus (John 9:1-41)

4/19	✚ Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 223: Unit 5, Lesson 27 – Pentecost Theme: The Church celebrates Pentecost fifty days after Easter Sunday. On this day, we recall the Gift of the Holy Spirit, who descended upon the Apostles in the form of wind & fire. Gospel Weekly Theme: We Follow Jesus' Way – On the Road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35)
