

Oct. 26	<p> Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 127: Unit 2, Lesson 12 – How Do We Respond to God’s Love? Theme: God’s law leads us to eternal happiness with Him. God’s Word is a source of moral guidance. Practice of virtues shows God we love Him. Gospel Weekly Theme: “For people who make themselves great will be humbled and those who humble themselves will be made great.” (Luke 18:9-4) Saints put God & others first* *All Saints Day is November 1: We are all called to be saints.</p>

Gospel Weekly Theme: Who are the Saints? “Whoever looks upon the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life.” (John 6:37-40)  All Souls’ Day is November 2 </p>

Dec. 14-3 rd Sun Advent	 Family Faith K-HS Families attend any Sunday Mass & arrive 10 minutes before Mass for Mass lesson. Christmas Pageant Will Take Place in Church after the 12 noon Mass (~1:15 pm).

Jan. 4, 2026 Epiphany	 Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 43: Unit 1, Lesson 4 – Who is Jesus Christ? Theme: Jesus is the promised Messiah. Jesus is truly God and truly man. Because of Christ's work of salvation we can have eternal life.. On January 1, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God . Gospel Weekly Theme: Epiphany – Foreign Kings Come to See Jesus.(Matthew 2:1-12)
Jan. 11 Baptism of Lord	 Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 85: Unit 2, Lesson 8 - How Do We Become Members of the Church? Theme: The Sacraments of Christian Initiation , Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, make us members of the Church. Gospel Weekly Theme: John Baptizes Jesus in the Jordan River. Jesus Invites Us to Be Like Him (Matthew 3:13-17)
Jan. 18	 Mass only – (MLK weekend – No Lessons today)

Theme: When we live as people of the Beatitudes, we will find true and lasting happiness. The Ten Commandments teach us that God is our first priority. Ten Commandments guide our actions toward others. Gospel Weekly Theme: Jesus Teaches the Beatitudes (Matthew 5:1-12a)

Confessions Lent	 Family Faith Come to Confession during Lent. Confessions will be offered on Monday evenings during Lent. Confessions are always available on Saturdays from 4:00-5:00 pm
Feb. 22 – 1 st Sun Lent	 Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg. 239: Unit 5, Lesson 24 – Lent Theme: Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting and charity that begins on Ash Wednesday Lent reminds us of Christ's sacrifice. Gospel Weekly Theme: Lent Calls Us to Make Choices (Matthew 4:1-11)
March 1 - 2 nd Sun Lent	 Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Unit 2, Lesson 9, Pg 95: – How do We Celebrate God's Forgiveness & Healing? Theme: Jesus offers us his forgiveness and healing. After Baptism, God forgives our sins in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation. Lent is here and this is a good time to review the Act of Contrition to prepare for Confession. Gospel Weekly Theme: Transfiguration: Jesu's divine nature is revealed to Peter, James and John. "Listen to Him."(Matthew 17:1-9)
3/8 - 3 rd Sun Lent	 Family Faith K-HS Families attend 8 am, 10 am Mass & arrive 10 minutes before Mass for Mass lesson. Stay in church after Mass for a 30-minute Eucharistic Adoration lesson w/Fr. Richard
3/15 - 4 th Sun Lent	 Mass/Class Mass. Arrive 10 min. before Mass for lesson. After Mass, go to school for a 30-minute class. Christ in Us, Pg 24: Unit 5, Lesson 25 Triduum – Why did Jesus die on the Cross and Rise Again? Theme: Triduum celebrates Jesu's work of redemption. The core celebrations of the Triduum are the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday evening, The commemoration of the passion and Death of the Lord on Good Friday and the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night. The Triduum ends on Easter Sunday night. Gospel Weekly Theme: Jesus Heals a Man Born Blind (John 9:1-41)

Theme: The Church celebrates Pentecost 50 days after Easter Sunday. As Jesus' disciples, we have a mission to proclaim the Good News Gospel Weekly Theme: Jesus is Always with Us/ On the Road to Emmaus (Luke 24:13-35)
