What is Cornerstone?



Cornerstone is a 26 – hour retreat that provides the opportunity to reflect, renew and strengthen one's faith while connecting with other women of our parish.

The retreat is planned by a team of women who have previously participated in a Cornerstone weekend. Their aim is to pamper you spiritually, emotionally and physically in a casual and welcoming atmosphere. It is a gift you can give yourself.

Who should attend?

Other than being at least 21 years old, Cornerstone isn't for any specific type of woman. It is for working and non-working women, mothers and non-mothers, married, single and divorced women. It is for women who attend Mass daily, as well as those who have been away from the Church and want to reconnect. It is for anyone looking for a deeper connection to God, self, and other women within our church community.

There is a place in Cornerstone for everyone.

What is the Goal of Cornerstone?

During the retreat, some team members will speak about various aspects of our Catholic faith and share personal stories on these topics. After each talk, participants are free to join in small group discussions, or simply sit back, listen and be inspired by these stories of the "Good News" of Jesus with us today.

The goal of Cornerstone is for each participant to revitalize and deepen her spiritual development. While prayer and quiet reflection are components of the weekend, so too, are faith-sharing and fellowship. Faith-sharing reveals how Christ, the Cornerstone, has played a significant role in each participant's journey.
