Who is My Sister/Brother?

On the question posited above we have three elements that qualify that unity of sisterhood/brotherhood. The first element is biological, it must be consanguineous. The second element is social in character and must have a social contract agreed to by all involved. The third and last one is posited by Christ today in the gospel where he stated in no ambiguous terms, "Whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister" Mk 3: 20-35. It is the principle of the last element that binds the three.

It is expected that your biological siblings will love you take care of you and abide by the family tradition. Likewise, the social sisterhood/brotherhood. They come together in love to form or forge an entity. They become friends and abide by the norms of their communities. The third group that Jesus alluded to are the people who are bound by the new law, which is to love one another as I have loved you. The foundational principle of all brotherhood/sisterhood is love, without which there would be no unity.

In 1984 we traveled to my mother's village where we were normally respected because we were children of their daughter called (*NWADIANI*). We could go

into any compound and pluck the fruits of the trees, to help ourselves without anyone telling us to stop. It was in our tradition that *NWADIANA* are treated like royals. When it was time to go back to the city, the people of my mother's village called (*NNAOCHIE*) would shower us with a lot of gifts and blessings and ask us to come back next holiday season. It was a treatment that got my brother Paschal wondering why this love is from people who are not from our village.

My father responded by saying that the rope of sisterhood/brotherhood is tied by love, not by blood. The tradition of our forefathers cherishes love above every other thing. The fact that their daughter agreed to leave the family where she was born and bred for a new family means her whole family should appreciate the outcome of that unity and love. That love they were showing you was what they have for their sister who is your mother. Paschal responded that those are the real brothers and sisters, not the people of Ifitedunu who don't allow us to pluck their oranges and mangoes during Christmas time.

What is the will of God? "Love one another".

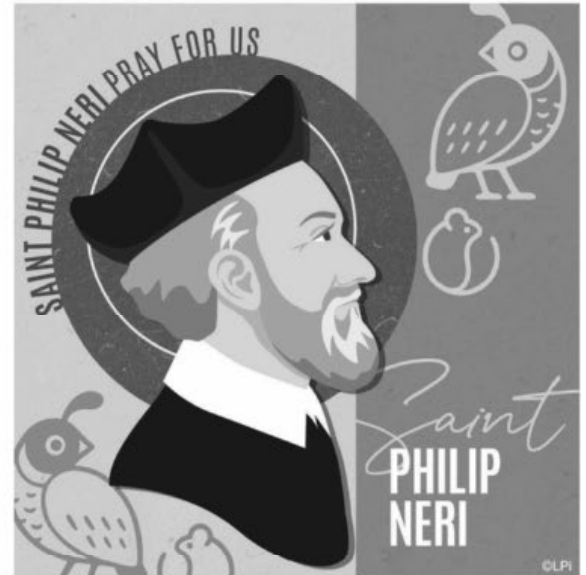

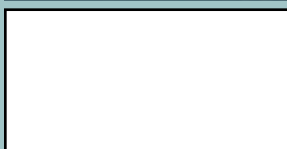
