Hello! St. Justin

Recently, I bid farewell to St. Martin of Tours Parish, where I served as parochial vicar for six years. In my parting message, I shared a reflection from Joyce Rupp on the word “goodbye,” which originally meant “God-be-with-ye.” This farewell is a mutual blessing—for those departing and those remaining. I carry the heartfelt blessings of that community with profound gratitude.

Now, I say “hello” to you, the St. Justin Parish Community. The Sufi mystic Rumi teaches us that “hello” means to “welcome and entertain” all who arrive at our door, even those we may find challenging. It's an invitation to open ourselves to whatever life brings, creating an opportunity for genuine encounter.

As I introduced myself to you, your warm “hello” allowed me to encounter not just you, but the presence of the Lord within each of you. I recognize that every one of you carries unique, sacred stories. Your greeting invites me to become part of these sacred narratives as I serve you as your pastor and servant-leader.

Allow me to briefly introduce myself:

I was born on January 3, 1966, in Pasay City, Manila, Philippines, the fourth of five children to Gregorio and Milagros Geronimo, who now

rest with our Heavenly Father. Baptized on the feast of St. Joseph (March 19, 1966), I was ordained as a deacon on March 14, 1992, and as a priest on December 3, 1992, by the late Jaime Cardinal Sin.

My education includes studies at San Carlos Major Seminary, courses on Priestly Formation in Italy (1995) and Ignatian Spirituality in England (1996), and training on Priestly Accompaniment and Formation in Missouri (2004).

My priestly ministry has included roles such as parochial vicar, spiritual director, Master of Liturgical Ceremonies, and Vicar for Clergy in the Archdiocese of Manila.

In the Diocese of San José, CA, I've served as parochial vicar in various parishes and as Vicar for Priests. I was incardinated in the Diocese of San José on March 21, 2024.

Having recently changed my official address, I am now making my home with you as the pastor of St. Justin Parish and Community.

Thank you for your warm welcome. I look forward to our journey together.

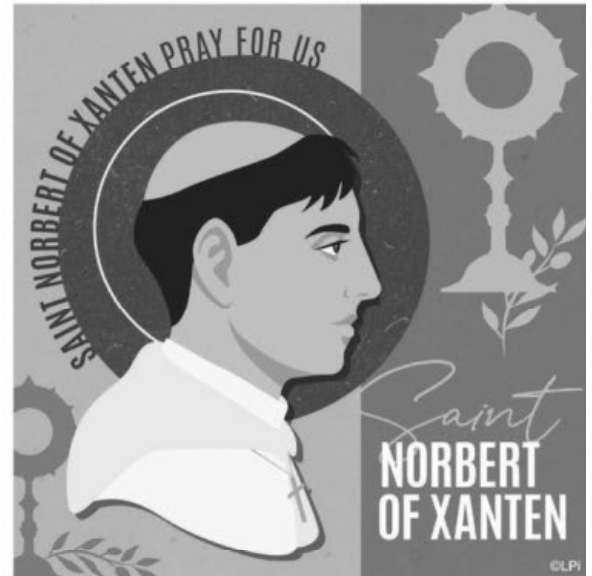

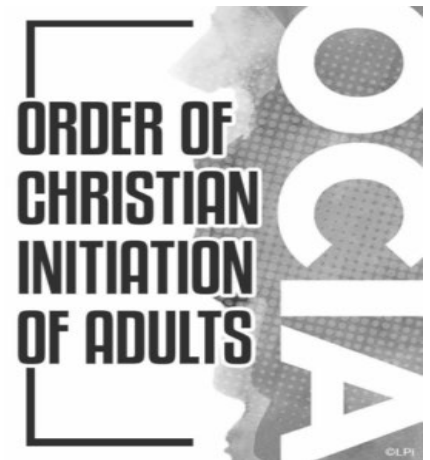


High School Confirmation Program

JESUS SENT OUT THE APOSTLES AND GAVE THEM AUTHORITY

In the first reading, King Amaziah did not want Amos to exercise the authority God had given him. He told him bluntly, "Off with you, visionary, never again prophesy in Bethel." Amos pleaded his case by saying that the Lord took him from following the flock and told him to go and prophesy to my people. The authority we receive from God is to be used for his people. I always ask God to direct my discussions with people, especially people who have different belief systems, opposing political views, and contrary societal innuendos. But I will never give up my authority because of fear, poverty, pride, or challenges. God is always sending us out the way he did with the apostles in today's reading. The question is simple, do we come back with success stories like the apostles?

Many months ago, someone came to me at the back of the church after Mass and said I should thank someone for him. I said can I see the person and why am I thanking the person for? He said that this person preached God to him during the last 49ers game and brought him back to

church after 10 good years of absence. I was quick to search for the person to express my gratitude also. Only two weeks ago another man came and said that he had a story, but first, he would like to take a picture with me and send it to his mother. I obliged him with the photo-op, and he beckoned to his friend and said "I am an Uber driver, and here is my passenger, and he told me to come back to church after my many years of absenteeism." I was impressed and overwhelmed because I, a priest, do not talk to my Uber drivers, and here is a person who always preaches Christ to his Uber drivers and has recorded success. He was using the authority he received from God perfectly.

Today we have been sent again by Jesus and the authority has been given to us. It is our duty to use it judiciously, not minding the location and time. If people can win souls for Christ inside Uber, or at the stadium, how much more can we do that in our family homes, classrooms, drinking spots, and pubs? Always remember that you have the authority of Christ to preach, to anoint, and to cure.
