Weekday and Sunday Masses: While I am not permitted to open up our weekday and Sunday Masses to the public, I am permitted to have up to 9 additional people at Mass. With this in mind, I have decided to celebrate weekday Mass at 6:30 p.m. and live-stream it on Facebook. After Mass, at 7:00, we will then pray the Rosary as we have been doing for the past several weeks. Sunday Mass will continue to be at 9:00 a.m. For Mass I will contact the family of the person that the Mass is being offered for and invite them to attend; then I will strive to always have a lector at Mass to assist with the readings; and from there I will strive to spread it out among the parishioners of both parishes. This way you will be given an opportunity to attend Mass and receive communion once in a while until we are able to open up completely. At these Masses we will observe social distancing, hand sanitizing and wearing of a face mask. If anyone is sick I ask that you decline from being present at these Masses until you are healthy. Our first 6:30 p.m. weekday Mass will be on Monday, May 4th.
