SCRIPTURES

June 5th –Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: THE CHILD OF THE MISTRESS OF THE HOUSE WHERE ELIJAH SOJOURNED BECAME ILL AND DIED. THE WOMAN PLEADED WITH ELIJAH WHO TOOK THE SON AND PRAYED OVER HIM. WHEN THE CHILD REVIVED ELIJAH RETURNED HIM TO HIS MOTHER WHO RECOGNIZED ELIJAH AS "A MAN OF GOD." (1 KINGS 17: 17-24)

SECOND READING: PAUL PROCLAIMS THE GOSPEL, NOT AS HUMAN, BUT COMING FROM THE REVELATION OF JESUS CHRIST. PAUL CONTINUES TO ACKNOWLEDGE HIS OWN SINFULNESS AND CALL TO GRACE. (GALATIANS 1: 11-19)

GOSPEL: THE GOSPEL CONTINUES TO RECOUNT THE MIRACLES AND HEALING POWERS OF JESUS. AS JESUS NEARED THE GATES TO THE CITY OF NAIN, THEY CAME UPON A DECEASED YOUNG MAN WHO WAS BEING CARRIED OUT OF THE CITY. HIS MOTHER, A WIDOW, AND A LARGE CROWD ACCOMPANYING THE BODY, MET JESUS ON THE WAY. COMPASSIONATELY, JESUS COMFORTS THE WEEPING MOTHER AND RESTORES LIFE TO THE DEAD MAN. (Luke 7: 11-17)

STEWARDSHIP by the BOOK- May 29, 2016

CORPUS CHRISTI

The Catholic Church is a custodian of the mysteries of God. Last weekend we celebrated one of those mysteries, The Holy Trinity. Today we celebrate another mystery, The Eucharist, or we celebrate one particular aspect of the Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Christ or Corpus Christi. The name “Eucharist” – meaning “thanksgiving” refers to the fact that at its institution, Christ “gave thanks” and also that this action is the supreme act of Christian gratitude to God. There are accounts of the institution of the Eucharist in Paul’s First Letter to the Corinthians, Chapter 11: 23-33, and also in Matthew, Mark and Luke.

The Church continually reminds us of the central role that the celebration of the Eucharist holds in our lives. It is in coming together as a community of faith around the Eucharistic table that not only do we express our faith but also we grow in solidarity and in our ability to express our faith. It is our active participation in this great prayer of the church that continues to remind us of the great challenge we face in living out the Gospel. It is only when we have taken part in the Penitential Rite, listened to God's word in the readings and Homily, and witnessed the changing of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ that we can approach the Table of the Lord to receive His Body and Blood.

The Feast of Corpus Christi is one way in which the church reminds us of the great mystery that we celebrate today. Literally “Corpus Christi” means “Body of Christ” and was the phrase the priest used as he distributed Communion before the Mass was celebrated in English. The change into English from Latin came about in 1970.

This Feast began to be celebrated in Liege- present day Belgium- in 1246 and Pope Urban IV extended it to the whole church in 1264. It was referred to back then as the Feast of the Blessed Sacrament.

Body of Christ: The church itself is also called The Body of Christ. It is the extension here on earth of Jesus, Himself. While we may receive the “Body of Christ”- Jesus- in Communion, we are still quite a way from being the “Body of Christ.”

As members of a Christian community of faith each of us is called to be a healer, reconciler, teacher, guide, forgiver. We fall short of that challenging task each week. This is why we begin each liturgy with the Penitential Rite. We acknowledge the fact that we are sinners. That reality will not change, but gathering around the Table of the Lord should help us to continue to become more fully the "Body of Christ."
