#### **SCRIPTURES:**

#### APRIL 28, 2019 Divine Mercy Sunday

First READING: THE PEOPLE HELD THE APOSTLES IN GREAT ESTEEM AND BROUGHT SICK PEOPLE TO THEM TO BE HEALED. ALTHOUGH SOME WERE AFRAID TO BE KNOWN, THE NUMBER OF JESUS' FOLLOWERS CONTINUED TO GROW STEADILY. (Acts 5:12-16)

SECOND READING: JOHN DEPICTS A VISION OF LAMP-STANDS OF GOLD AND ONE LIKE THE SON OF MAN IN A ROBE WITH A SASH OF GOLD. THIS APPARITION TOLD JOHN THAT HE HAD NOTHING TO FEAR AND THEN DESCRIBED HIMSELF AS ONE WHO WAS DEAD BUT NOW LIVED AGAIN. HE THEN INSTRUCTED JOHN TO RECORD ANY OTHER VISIONS HE MIGHT HAVE. (REVELATIONS 1: 9-11A, 12-13, 17-19)

GOSPEL: JESUS APPEARED TO THE DISCIPLES AND BREATHED ON THEM SAYING, "RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT." HE GIVES THEM THE POWER TO FORGIVE PEOPLE'S SINS OR HOLD THEM ACCOUNTABLE . THOMAS, WHO WAS NOT PRESENT, REFUSED TO BELIEVE JESUS HAD APPEARED UNTIL HE CAME TO THEM ONCE MORE. JESUS TOLD THOMAS TO BELIEVE AND ADDED, "BLESSED ARE THOSE WHO HAVE NOT SEEN AND HAVE BELIEVED." (John 20: 19-31)

# THE JOY of EASTER

"Whoever is a devout lover of God, let him enjoy this beautiful, bright festival! Whoever is a grateful servant let him rejoice and enter into the joy of His Lord!

Rich and poor, dance with one another, sober and slothful, celebrate the day. Those who have kept the fast and those who have not, rejoice today, for the table is richly spread. Fare royally upon it, the calf is a fatted one. Let no one go away hungry. All of you enjoy the banquet of faith! All enjoy the richness of His goodness.

Let no one fear death, for the death of our Savior has set us free. He has destroyed it by enduring it. Christ is risen and the demons are cast down. Christ is risen and life is set free. Christ is risen and the tomb is emptied of the dead. For Christ having risen from the dead, is become the first-fruits of those who sleep. To him be glory and power forever and ever! Amen." (From the Easter Sermon of St. John Chrysostem)

These words of the fourth century preacher capture the power and majesty of Easter. The pain and darkness of Good Friday give way to unlimited possibility and hope on Easter morn. The bonds of death cannot hold Jesus captive and so we rejoice and alleluia becomes our song.

Today let us be happy and forget all our troubles. Jesus is risen! May the Risen Lord bless you with peace and joy this Easter!
