

Our Baptismal Ministry is pleased to help your family prepare for the special event of your child's entrance into our faith community. Please contact the parish office at least two months prior to your preferred Baptism date to schedule a preparation class. We encourage attendance at this class well before the baby's birth. The class is usually offered the last Monday evening of each month. Baptisms are scheduled on Sundays at 1:00 p.m.

Saturday from 4:00pm—4:30pm or by appointment.

Sacraments of Initiation

Adults interested in receiving the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation) may call the Director of our RCIA program, Deacon Tim Leonard.

Sacrament of Marriage

Please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding to set a date and to begin your marriage preparation and required paper work.

Home or Hospital Visitation

Anyone who cannot attend Mass because of age or illness, and would like to receive the Eucharist at home, should call the parish office to arrange a visit. Likewise, if you are being admitted to the hospital, and would like a visit, please call. Due to confidentiality reasons, hospitals no longer call the parish to inform us when parishioners are admitted.




SPRED Mass a Beautiful Success

From the Finance Council:

The Finance Council meets to advise the Parish and help provide guidance for the overall financial stability of Prince of Peace. We are also required to provide the Parish with an annual update.

This weekend you heard Fr. Gerald talk about the need to evaluate what you personally do to give back to God what you have been blessed with. We would also like to ask you to prayerfully consider your Sunday contributions. We offer these reflections: Today's Gospel says,

"While some people were speaking about how the temple was adorned with costly stones and votive offerings,"

Sometimes we feel that there is nothing more to do at our beautiful Parish. All the money has been collected, and all the facilities have been constructed, and all the bills are already paid. However Jesus said,

"All that you see here the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."

Although this sounds very dire and we do not believe that our beloved Prince of Peace Parish will be "thrown down", it does bring to mind that we must continue the great work that we, and the others before us, have done to continue to keep our Parish a strong and vibrant community.

Jesus also speaks of famine and plagues and earthquakes. Once again, I do not believe that these will happen to us, but the modern versions that affect us are increased building costs, wear and tear on our facilities, and day to day operational costs.

The Gospel continues to speak about the difficulties that lie ahead for Jesus' disciples and we think that we all will have our own issues that we need to deal with and we especially like the end which states,

"By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

This to us says that we have all done a great job of building and maintaining this beautiful Parish not just with brick and mortar but also our friendships and ministries that bring so much to us and our community.

Let's continue to build our Parish and remember that there is an old saying that we think rings very true as we look to the future;

"We do not inherit the Earth from our ancestors. We borrow it from our children."

With this in mind let us reflect on the ways that we can continue to support our Parish for the future:

- We offer our time to ministry work within the parish and reaching out to the community.
- · We offer our talents to lend a hand with a project around the parish or our knowledge and experience in the planning for the future.
- We offer our treasure to sustain the parish that we have grown. That we have been handed from those before us to nurture and watch flourish for those who we will pass this wonderful parish to.
