Prince of Peace 2020 Lenten Almsgiving Project

Dear Prince of Peace parishioners,

I once again want to say what a privilege and a pleasure it has been serving as your Music Director these past seven months. I have enjoyed making music with the choirs as well as your singing. It is such an inspiration. As we draw closer to the Lenten season, I want to inform you about the project for this year. As you may have recalled, last year September, my home country of the Bahamas had experienced the worst hurricane in history to ever come to our shores. My heart was broken for my people who lost so much.

I remember feeling helpless, as I watched in horror from the safety of the United States, as my country was being ravaged by a category 5 hurricane. In the aftermath, time seemed to drag on forever as I waited for the slow confirmation that my friends and family members were safe. I appreciate all of you who have reached out, prayed and shown much concern. I didn't feel so alone any more, as a matter of fact it was then that I realized I had found a new family. Except for loss or damaged property, my friends and family were ok. They were the lucky ones.

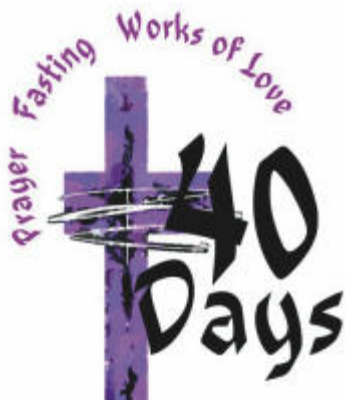
The Bahamas is an Archipelago nation made up of 700 islands and cays, with 19 of them being inhabited. The islands that suffered the most impact were the northern most islands of Grand Bahama and Abaco. The estimated damage is somewhere around US \$3.4 Billion, with about 100 dead and 300 still missing after the storm.

I was deeply moved by you, the members of Prince of Peace, for your eagerness to support the Bahamas hurricane relief, and Fr. Gerald, for suggesting this as the theme of this year's Lenten project. I am proud to be spearheading this project not only because I am Bahamian, but because I have always felt a calling to bring healing where there is great loss. I pray God continues to use me as His instrument.

Throughout the Lenten season I will be informing you about hurricane Dorian and how you can help with our Lenten Almsgiving Project. I am having ongoing conversations with people who have been on ground zero and witnessed the storm first hand. I will share their testimonials and recent updates, as well as some of my own personal experiences with previous hurricanes in the Bahamas. I have also connected with the Archdiocese of the Bahamas and gained the support of Archbishop Patrick Pinder. He expresses his deep gratitude for your prayers and continued support. It is my hope that this project will be of some significance to the rebuilding of what was lost. Please continue to keep the Bahamas in your prayers, and again thank you for being my family.

Prince of Peace 2020 Parish Mission Begins Tonight!

"It is the perfect way to begin Lent. Helps me to focus on Jesus Christ's sacrifice, death and resurrection."

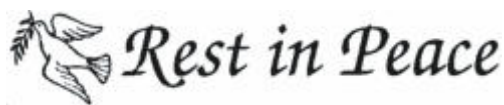
"Patti and I attend the parish mission because it 'centers' our minds and hearts in preparation for Lenten prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Any time spent focusing on our faith and Jesus is time well spent."

Our parish mission this year will be led by Fr. Richard Fragomeni, who is an Associate Professor of Liturgy and Homiletics at Chicago Theological Union. He also serves as rector of The Shrine of Our Lady of Pompeii in Chicago's Little Italy and is a nationally acclaimed speaker, author and retreat master. The theme for this year's mission will be DISCIPLESHIP. It will begin on February 23 and conclude on February 25th. All of the nights will begin at 7:00 pm.

Sunday we will reflect on the question of "What is Discipleship?" Looking back at the early Church, it started with a small group of 72 disciples, both men and women, who through their belief in Jesus, helped Christianity grow to over 2 billion followers today. We are part of that Church.

On Monday, we will examine the theme of discipleship as the living Body of Christ because as Catholics we are given the Eucharist as the Source and Summit of our Faith. We gather every Sunday to give thanks for the gift of Christ's Body and Blood and this provides us the strength to be His disciples.

The mission will conclude on Tuesday night with a call to discipleship for each of us. In other words, we are called to discipleship in the world. This is what it means to be an evangelistic people; to take the message we have been given, the Eucharist we have shared, and bring it into a world in need. Our faith is lived in the world.

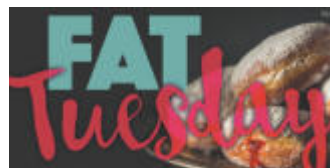

Lenten Disciplines of Fasting & Abstinence

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.
