

A TIME TO PREPARE

The Advent Season is upon us. Perhaps this year, more than in previous years, we need the joy of Christmas. Since Advent is the period of anticipation that leads to Christmas it brings both the beginning of the joy we crave, and the stress of preparing for the holiday.

Our lives seem to speed up with the need to continue to live out our daily lives, but also do the things that are necessary to ensure that we have everything just right for the celebration. We search for just the right gifts, spend time wrapping them and ensuring that if they need to be shipped that they will get there on time. My family's tradition involves the production of many different types of cookies, and for me, the consumption of a great deal of cookie dough.

Yes, there is so much to do at this time of year that it is very easy to forget, as they say, "The Reason for the Season." Advent should be first and foremost the time we prepare to celebrate the birth of the Son of God. We should search for the gifts that would be what HE would want for His birthday. This would seem hard, because, what do you get for the God who created everything?

First, we should ensure that we mend any rift we might have with Him by receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We often get so busy that we forget the need to be reconciled to our God. What better way to welcome the Christ Child then with a clean soul. We should also mend any rifts we have with others, especially members of our family.

Perhaps a donation to a food pantry or other charity, if you are able, to help our less fortunate brothers and sisters could be a gift. You can fill His stocking with acts of kindness shown to others. Simple acts like a kind word of encouragement or even a smile may seem small, but often have a great effect on the person who receives them or others who witness them.

We could spend more time in prayer talking to God and also spending time in quiet listening for His message. The noise of our daily lives often prevents us from hearing what God wants us to know. Prayer and quiet are also a great way to handle the stress that seems to surround us every day.

One last gift idea is taking some time to learn about the Faith He gave us. Study the Bible, view some of the offerings on FORMED (the Parish's gift to you), listen to EWTN or Catholic media outlets.

I've said that Advent is a time of preparation, and it is my hope that you will use this time to get ready for the coming of the Christ Child. I look forward to seeing you, at the end of Advent, at one of the Christmas Masses. If you are unable to attend please watch the online Mass from Prince of Peace.



Catholic Charities Christmas Share Program 2020

We wanted to give you an update on our Christmas Share Program plans for this year.

Catholic Charities is preparing for the annual Christmas Gift Program. Last year, they provided gifts across Lake County for over 13,000 needy children. Due to the pandemic and the increased risk of bringing gifts onto our parish campus, we are going to work with them on an alternative plan for this year. This alternative consists of purchasing gift cards instead of actual gifts. These cards can be purchased from Walmart, Target, Kohl's or any another store where you might have bought gifts in the past. We ask that whatever amount you would have spent on a gift in past years, be purchased for this year. Then along with the gift card, enclose a note specifying what age range you would like them to purchase for. Catholic Charities will then go out and purchase the gifts. They will do the best they can to honor your request.

While this is certainly not ideal, given the pandemic we must follow these guidelines. We know that picking the tags, purchasing and then wrapping the gifts, bringing them back to be placed on the altar, and then sorting them for transport to the warehouse, is a wonderful project for our parish community. As a staff, we certainly do miss that visual connection. We also have committed to this project and expressed that we hope it returns to the previous format next year.

Donations of gift cards will accepted the weekend of November 28-29 and December 5-6. They can be dropped off when you come to Mass. They can also be dropped off on Monday, November 30th from 5:00pm - 8:00pm while Adoration is being prayed in the church. You can also email me at jminor@princeofpeacelv.org, and we can make arrangements for a drop off time at the parish.

We thank you for your understanding and hope to make this a wonderful Christmas for the needy children of Lake County.



After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.






