

## From the Pastor's Desk



This weekend we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. Mother Angelica tells a lovely story about Divine Mercy. Once she was at a beach in California, standing near the surf. A big wave came in and the water washed over her shoes. A drop of water hit her hand and she looked at it. Then she looked out to the vast sea. She heard the Lord's voice speaking inside her, "Angelica, that drop represents all your sins, all your imperfections and all your frailties. Throw it in the ocean." She threw it back. Then she heard the Lord say, "The ocean is My mercy. Now if you looked for that drop, would you ever find it?"

"No, Lord," she replied. Mother Angelica then told the people in her audience that their sins are like that drop in the ocean. "Every day, every minute of the day, throw your drop in the ocean of his His mercy. Then, don't worry, just try harder."

We spend too much time focusing on our failings - and not enough on God's Mercy. Pope Francis said on Divine Mercy, "Jesus' attitude is striking: we do not hear the words of scorn, we do not hear words of condemnation, but only words of love, of mercy, which are an invitation to conversation. "Neither do I condemn you; go, and do not sin again." Ah! Brothers and Sisters, God's face is the face of a merciful father who is always patient. Have you thought about God's patience, the patience He has with each one of us? That is His mercy. He always has patience, patience with us, He understands us, He waits for us, He does not tire of forgiving us if we are able to return to Him with a contrite heart. "Great is God's mercy," says the Psalm." (March 17, 2013)

The Divine Mercy image, has rays of light coming from the wounds. The rays have two colors: red and white. The white refers to baptism and the red to the Eucharist - the great sacraments by which we receive the divine mercy. Between them we might see another sacrament: Reconciliation, which is a "second baptism" enabling us to approach the Eucharist - if we have committed a grave sin.

Psalm 118 repeats the words, "His mercy endures forever." Jesus invites us to the ocean of mercy - to throw into that ocean our sins, so they can never be found again.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled week.




#### The Make A Meal Ministry, Serving God's People ...



## **Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?**



This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.
