

From the Desk of Deacon James Even



"In asking for Baptism for your children, you are undertaking the responsibility of raising them in the faith, so that, keeping God's commandments, they may love the Lord and their neighbor as Christ has taught us. <u>Do you understand this responsibility?</u>" – from **The Roman Ritual** - **The Order of Baptism for Children**.

As parents we all want what is best for our children – we strive to give them the best we can, many times at great sacrifice to ourselves: the best child seats to keep them safe in

the car, the best doctors, the best education – we want to equip our children to give them every advantage to help them face this world head on.

And Baptism is no exception.

When asked at the many baptismal preparation classes I have led, why a parent or couple wants to have their child baptized in the Catholic Church, invariably the answer is "so that my child has the same faith that I had growing up". We know that the Faith is something that is an invaluable help in life, and that baptism is the first step in that faith, but we also must remember the words at the top of this page taken from the beginning of the Rite of Baptism; that the passing on of the Faith is not just a thing we do at one point in time that leaves us good to go – it is a responsibility that we have taken on that lasts a lifetime, even if we are not sure 100% how it will happen...

Earlier in the Rite, though, there is a promise from the Church as well – "This Community rejoices with you...
... and we offer you our support in raising your children in the practice of the Faith."

In other words, you are not alone here at Prince of Peace.

All of us need help at times with our own Faith life and especially in passing that treasure to our children and that is the very mission of our Religious Education Program.

We are blessed to have dedicated and talented catechists who love their faith and love teaching it and sharing it with the next generation. From Kindergarten through the sacrament of Confirmation, we are here to help you pass on the Faith and, with you, equip your children to face the world in the Love and Hope that that Faith brings.



Consecration to Blessed Virgin Mary

Following our Consecration to St. Joseph earlier this year, it was suggested that we also offer a Consecration to Mary. We are excited to announce this will begin July 25th, the Feast of St. James the Apostle and end on September 8th the Feast of the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

To consecrate oneself means "to set aside for a particular purpose." In other words, when it comes to our relationship with the Mother of Jesus, it means entrusting ourselves to her care, bringing to her all of our concerns, as well as our praise.

The preparation for the consecration will involve a meeting once a week, a short daily prayer time, a gathering for the actual consecration liturgy and then a commitment to maintain the graces that have been received during the preparation period.



Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.
