

From the Pastor's Desk



The ancient Irish monks and Celtic divine spoke and talked about the "thin places" – places where heaven and earth overlap. To be in a "thin place" is to be in the present, real world we know but somehow, at the same time, see or touch the world of God, as well. An Irish poet once described "thin places," both seen and unseen, as places "where the door between the world / And the next is cracked open for a moment / And the light is not all on the other side. God shaped space. Holy."

Celtic spirituality associated thin places most often with wild landscapes: rugged mountaintops, windswept islands, and the rugged seacoast that continue to be places of pilgrimages for Christians. Any place or encounter in which one experiences a sense of the divine, the holy, the sacred, is a thin place.

Theologian Marcus Borg writes that a "thin place is anywhere our hearts are opened. They are places where the boundary between the two levels become very soft, porous, permeable. Thin places are places where the veil momentarily lifts and we behold the Divine all around us.

We can all relate to what St. Peter experienced on the mountaintop. All of us have had similar experiences in life. We have experienced times when, for a split second, we seemed to glimpse another world beyond this one. They are moments when, for an instant, we see beyond ordinary events to something extraordinary. They are moments of transfiguration (thin places) when, like Peter, James, and John, we are overwhelmed by a remarkable sense of God's presence.

And if we listen carefully when these moments occur, we, too, may hear a heavenly voice say, "This is my own dear Son, with whom I am pleased-listen to him!"

Unfortunately, we don't follow through on these experiences. Unfortunately, we even forget they ever happened. Or even more unfortunately, as we grow older we don't walk outside to watch a sunset or we no longer climb mountains to invite such experiences to take place. The truth of the matter is that the risen Jesus is constantly revealing his presence to us. But we are too busy to notice. We are too busy to pause to look for him.

Today's gospel speaks to this situation. It tells us that Jesus is the Son of God. It tells us that Jesus is risen. It tells us that Jesus wants to show himself to us through our family, through our children, through nature, through our gathering here each Sunday.

Today's gospel invites us to look for Jesus not only in the extraordinary events of life but also in the very ordinary ones. Jesus is everywhere in our world. Jesus wants us to look for him. Jesus is waiting for us. We need only look. This is the message and the invitation of today's gospel.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled Lent.







Stewardship of treasure involves trust in God. You have to really believe in God's Providence and trust that, if you give 10 percent of your income to church and charity, for example, God will help you live on the rest.

Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.

What is the Elijah Cup?

The purpose of the Elijah Cup, a chalice, used during the Consecration of the Mass, is to provide a focal point for prayer. We are all aware of the need for vocations to the priesthood, the permanent diaconate or to the religious life. But sometimes we forget just how powerful praying for an increase in vocations can be. If we pray with the faith of the widow of Zarapeth, our cup will never run dry! We will always have priests to bring us Jesus in the Eucharist.

How does it work?

Each month, a family, a couple, or individual, has the opportunity to bring a chalice that has held the Consecrated Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ into their homes. The Elijah Cup serves as a focal point encouraging family prayer for religious vocations, for seminarians and for our serving religious. It is a powerful presence and inspires prayer from adults and children alike.
