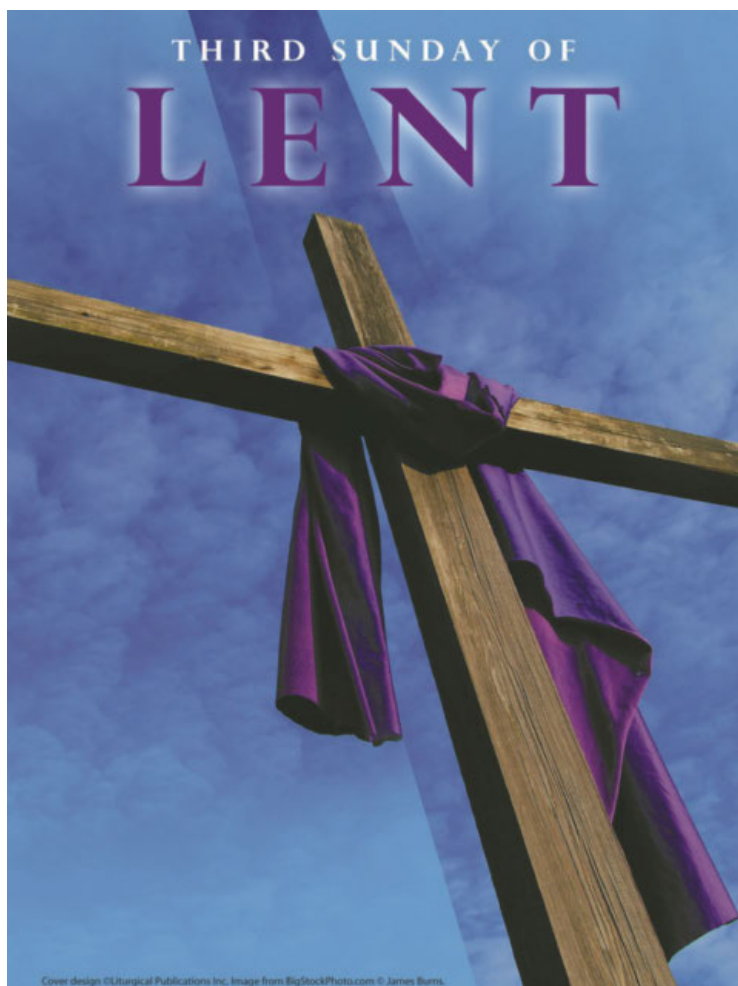

## *From the Pastor's Desk*



The story of the Woman at the Well in the Gospel of Saint John is incredibly rich and full of meaning. It certainly offers plenty of material for fruitful meditation during this season of Lent.

It says in our Gospel reading that many Samaritans of that town believed in Jesus on the strength of the woman's testimony. She came to faith herself and became the occasion of faith for those others because as she said, 'He told me all I have ever done.' And, of course, what she had done was not very creditable having five so-called husbands. What she had done was sinful but Christ, despite his extensive knowledge of her sins, speaks to her with great respect and acceptance. And he goes much further than this, he promises her living water, water that will be the key to eternal life. We realize here that he is referring to the waters of Baptism.

This Season of Lent is a time when we try to do something extra for God, something which will strengthen our faith and make us better Christians. There are many ways we can do this; traditionally people have focused on fasting and giving things up. But there are other things we can do which would have a real spiritual benefit and would strengthen our Christian faith.

Let me suggest that reading the Bible would be a good thing to do during Lent. Step one is to make certain that you actually have a Bible, there surely ought to be one in every Catholic home. But often it is on the lowest shelf and covered in dust. So start today, blow the cobwebs off and open it at today's reading about the Woman at the Well and read it again, then focus on just the first couple of lines of the reading. (John 4:5-42)

Think about that woman going out to get water as she did thousands of times. Think about her meeting with Christ who came to her amidst this ordinary daily tasks and asked her for a drink. Think about the routine actions in your own life. Think about how he often comes to you when you are carrying out such mundane tasks and think about the disguises he uses. Ask yourself if he was here now what would he be asking you.

This Gospel about the Woman of Samaria gives us great hope for the future. It tells us that Christ constantly comes to us; it tells us that our faith is alive; it tells us that the supply of Living Water is infinite and will always be there for us to draw on.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled Lent.

## Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.



You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.
