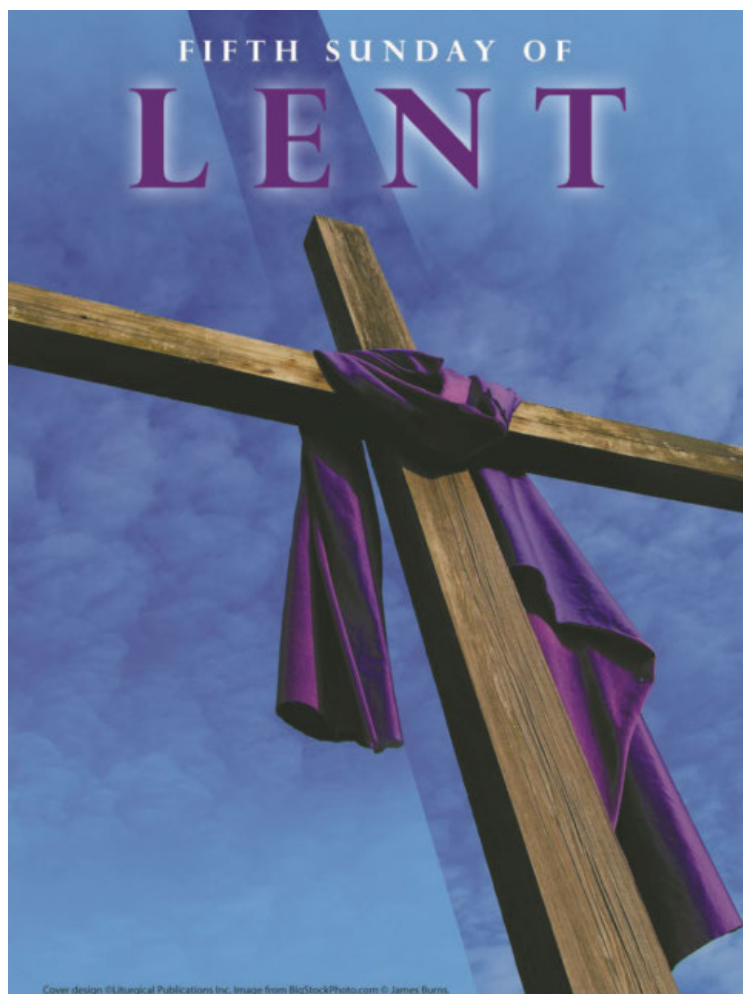

From the Associate Pastor's Desk



Marriage In the Bible

When I was a young seminarian living at my internship parish, I met a couple that was married thirty-five or more years. This married couple went to many parish activities but they were inconsistent in how much time each one spent there and which ones they attended. This couple perplexed me with what seemed to be a very odd schedule. After a while, I learned more about the couple. I learned that the wife loved going to parish activities, but the husband did not like to stay that long. However they wanted to do activities together, so sometimes they stayed longer. This meant that the husband sacrificed his preference to be with his wife. Sometimes they left earlier which meant that the wife sacrificed her preference to be with her husband. This is how they made many decisions in their marriage. They always put the other spouse first and what the other desired. By always putting the other person's needs first, they in fact put their marriage first.

This couple was living out what St. Paul writes to the Ephesians in Chapter 5 Verses 21-33. In verse 21 we heard "Be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ." Reverence for Christ causes the couple to respond to Christ with their own holiness. Christ being perfect holiness, shows a husband how to love his wife in verse 25, "Husbands, love your wives, as Christ, loved the Church and gave himself for her." "Her" is the Church. Mr. Michael Lawler who wrote a short article on Ephesians, chapter 5 states that verse 25 is saying "A Christian Husband, therefore, is instructed to be head over his wife by serving, giving way to, and giving himself up for her. Headship and authority modeled on those of Christ does not mean control, giving orders, making unreasonable demands, reducing another human person to the status of servant, or worse, slave to one's every whim." The couple I mentioned earlier gave way to one another and did not try to control, give orders, or make unreasonable demands.

Christ showed us what true love is by being committed to the Church. With this in mind let us go back to verses 22 and 27; the verses that can easily catch our ear. "Wives be subject to your husbands, as to the Lord. And as the Church is subject to Christ, so let wives also be subject in everything towards her husband's." The love a wife has for a husband is the same love the Church, the body of Christ, has for her head, Christ. The Church loves Christ and what He did for the Church. Christ gave up his life in order for the Church to become "holy and without blemish." We heard these words in verse 27. It is proper for a wife to be like the Church; to love her husband in order for him to become more holy and without blemish. A husband cannot become holy and without blemish by controlling his wife, ordering her to be a slave for him. A husband does not love his wife if he treats her like a slave. Christ showed us how to love by giving up everything even His life. A husband and a wife sacrifice everything, even their personal preferences and desires to give everything to one another. Mr. Lawler says, and I agree with him, that this passage is not saying that husbands should think of themselves "as supreme lord and master of his wife."

Christ shows us true marital love by putting the other first. How do we put the other first and if we are married, do we act like a supreme ruler, or one who desires increased holiness and heaven for the other person?

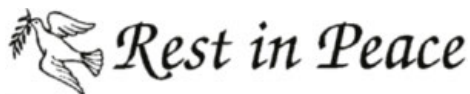

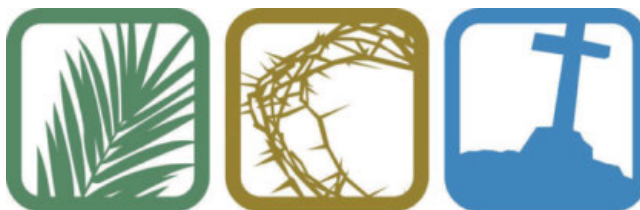

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.
