From the Pastor's Desk



Today is known as Good Shepherd Sunday and it is a Day of Prayer for Vocations; and by vocations we mean vocations to the Priesthood, Diaconate and the Religious Life. There are certainly many other vocations such as those to the married life, or vocations to various other professions such as nursing or teaching but today we are thinking about vocations for service specifically within the Church.

Only a few years ago we would probably have just said it was a Day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and the Religious Life - we'd have forgotten about the diaconate altogether. But today we cannot forget the diaconate since it is the fastest growing area of vocations in the Church.

And particularly here at Prince of Peace, we are very conscious of the diaconate since our deacons: James (Sabrina) Even, Tim (Mary) Leonard, Jim (Nancy) Minor, Jack (Patti) Ruskin, Chris (Jeni) Savage, Mark (Joan) Weiss, and retired Jeff (Sue) Barton are very active and very involved in our faith community. We are also blessed to have George (Kristin) Schmelter in the diaconate program and will be ordained on May 13th. In addition to these men we have been particularly blessed to have seminarians Peter Binder and Thiet Hoang from Mundelein Seminary assisting us as they prepare for priesthood for the Archdiocese of Dubuque, Iowa.

As you see above, we are very blessed here at Prince of Peace with the number of deacons we have ministering to us. I would like to answer some questions about the diaconate as George prepares to be ordained in a couple of weeks.

We all know that deacons were right there at the very beginning of the Church and that St Stephen, the first martyr, was a deacon. They came into being because the Apostles needed helpers so they could devote themselves entirely to the preaching of the Gospel and how this came about is specifically recorded in the Acts of the Apostles. The deacons were initially to look after administrative duties and to specifically care for the poor, but as representatives of the Apostles they were also engaged in preaching the Gospel and many other duties.

The Sacrament of Ordination is divided into three levels, that of Bishop, Priest and Deacon. The Second Vatican Council made many needed reforms to the life of the Church and one of its most important reorganizations was to the diaconate. The Council reintroduced what we now call the Permanent Diaconate and permitted married (or single) men to be ordained as deacons to serve solely in that capacity and not as just as a stage to the priesthood.

In the Church today a deacon is able to perform baptisms, marriages and funerals and to preach at Mass. He is able to lead all kinds of devotions and trains others in the faith and in preparation for the reception of the sacraments. It is his special duty to read the Gospel at Mass no matter how many other priests or bishops are present. In communities without a resident priest the deacon can also be appointed to exercise leadership in the parish.

We here at Prince of Peace should be very proud to have these fine men ordained to this important vocation and we should support them with our prayers and good wishes.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled Easter Season.

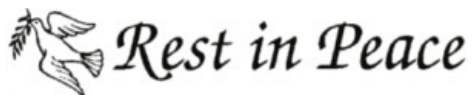

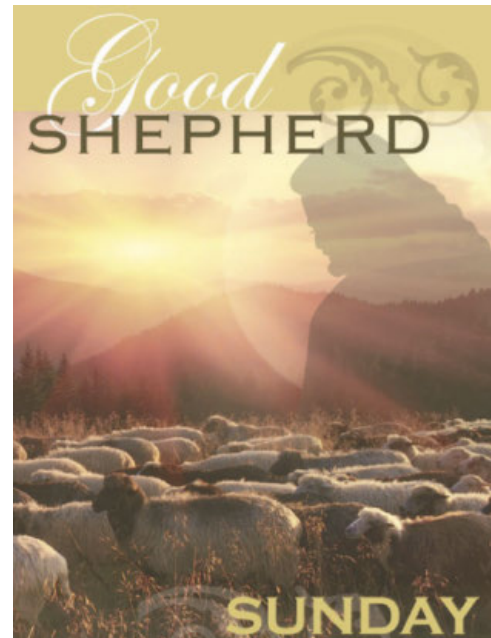

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.



You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.

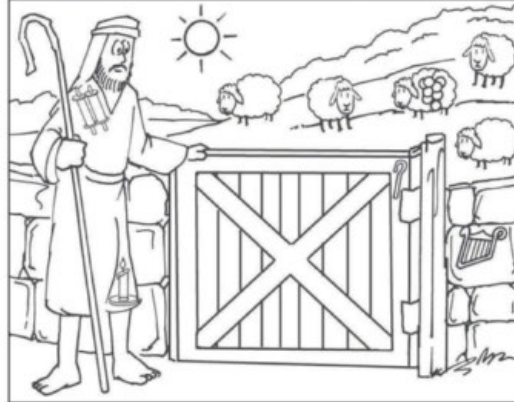

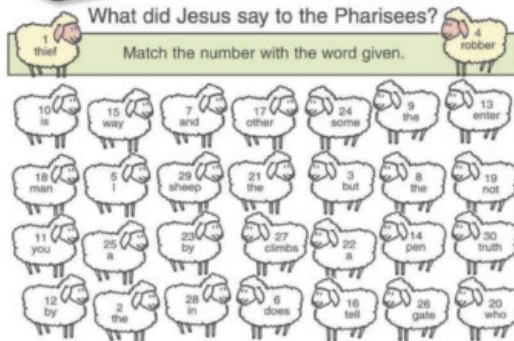
