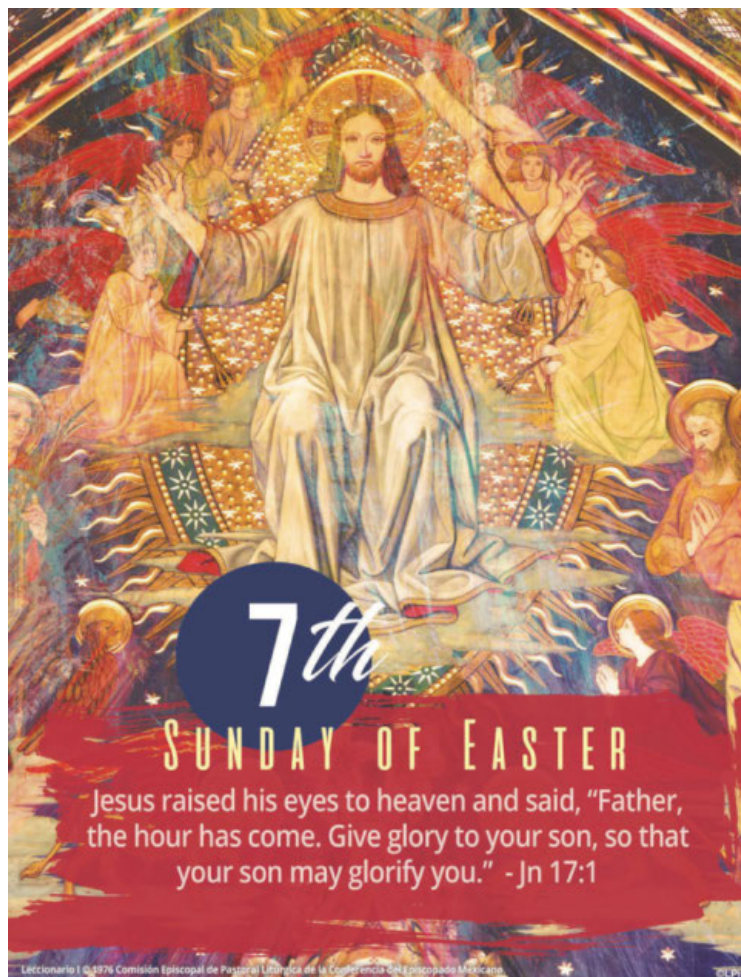

From the Desk of Deacon George Schmelter



Today we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of our Lord. After 40 days spent with the apostles, Jesus is once again leaving them. However, unlike the separation they experienced at the crucifixion, Jesus tells them that He will come again. Christ gave them the great commission to make disciples of all nations.

Becoming a disciple is more than going through the motions, coming to church once a week, praying occasionally. It is an ongoing process of personal change. Our lives must be focused on becoming holy. Our Lord wants us to become saints. How do we do this? Make God the priority in our lives. Attending Mass is a good start, but when we come, do we participate fully? Do we prepare ourselves to receive Jesus in the Eucharist? Do we spend time in prayer each day? Do we spend time with scripture?

We should ask ourselves “What do I have in my life that keeps me further away from God? Am I preoccupied with material possessions? Are some of my relationships unhealthy? Do I hold a grudge against someone and refuse to forgive?” Growing in holiness requires effort. I know, because I am a work in progress and I have a long way to go.

We must prepare because Christ will come again. Like a thief in the night, we will not know the hour. But imagine if we lived each day as though Christ were coming tomorrow? Would we worry about the many earthly troubles we all seem to focus on? Would we worry about money, health, food, clothing? Or would we focus on ensuring that we will be ready for His return? When we know we have company coming, don’t we clean the house, put on nice clothes and make sure that we make a good impression for our guest? Why should we do less for the Savior who sacrificed everything for our salvation.

Here on the Feast of the Ascension, we are given the opportunity to cherish one of our faith’s deepest truths: the Return of Christ, the Fulfillment of His promise, the coming of all good things. Indeed: He who has been taken up into heaven will return in the same way He was seen going into heaven.

This is not a farewell; it is a see you soon. Not goodbye, but till we meet again. Not a moment of sadness, but of grateful anticipation. Prepare yourselves for the glorious day when the Lord will come again.
