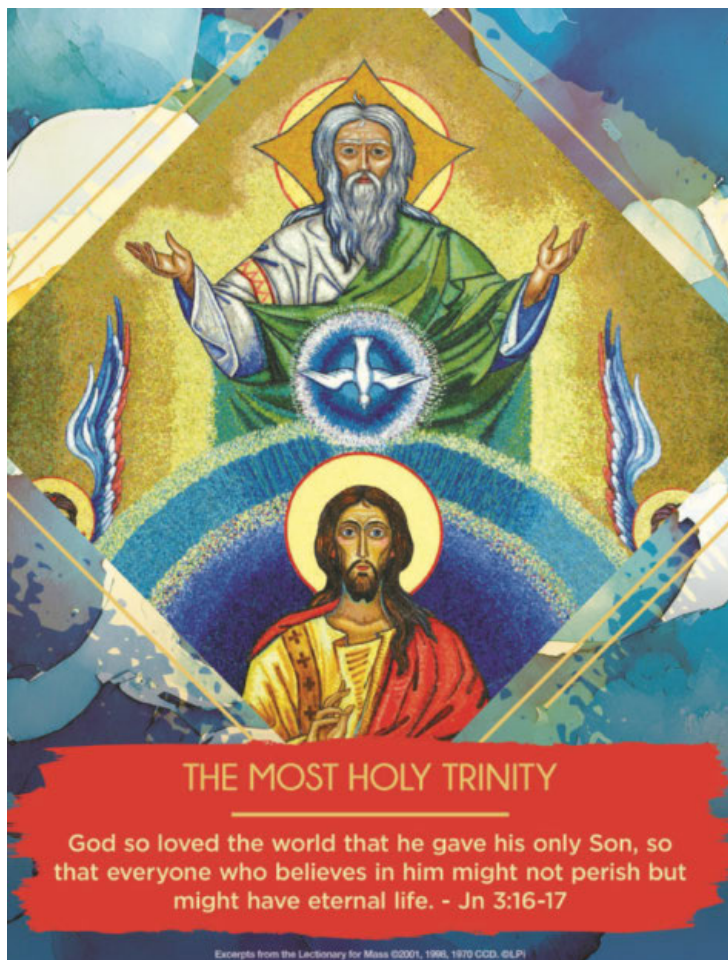

From the Pastor's Desk



We can't always simply believe in something because we see it in front of our faces. As the saying goes, "There is more to life than meets the eye." There comes a time in which we need faith. At some point in our lives, if we are to live a life with any sense of purpose and meaning, we have to confront exactly what we believe – and be willing to pay whatever price for that belief, that concept of "truth" we hold dear.

Today's feast of the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity calls us to recognize the fingerprints of God in every molecule of creation, in every moment of inspiration, in every work of peace. Faith begins with realizing that the Holy Spirit of God breathes life into all that exists; faith then compels us to continue the creative work of God and to embrace the love of God that is part of every wonder of nature and every sign of compassion.

The Spirit invites us to seek the life of God, as revealed and taught by Jesus in the Gospel. Christ calls us and all who would be his disciples to embrace the Gospel with the honesty and confidence of the human heart. We should be enthusiastic about our ministry.

That is why Jesus gives us the Holy Spirit to inspire us, guide us and energize us to share the Gospel message with those around us. Our hearts should be burning within us when we share our lives with those who are in search of some help.

Let us pray that God, the giver of everything that is good, will provide us with the wisdom of the Holy Spirit to discover the goodness in all things so that we can change our lives for the better. By doing so, we can also help others transform their lives and make this world a better place to live in.

And maybe we can share that lesson with all people so everyone can understand how the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit are so important to believe in. And if they begin to believe, then they won't have to quickly change the subject.

Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a “Donate” button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.



You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.
