

From the Associate Pastor's Desk



Chapter 4: Charisms, Gifts and Symbols of the Sprits Book by Charles Meyer, What a Modern Catholic Believes About The Holy Spirit,

Chapter 4

A modern Catholic believes that the Spirit has many great powers and can do many great and extraordinary things. Certain Christians possess these great powers not only for

themselves but as a witness to God's presence in the community. These great powers of the Holy Spirit are called charisms. The two classes of charisms either belong to an office or ministry in the Church or given to individuals for the benefit of the community. Monsignor Meyer focuses on the latter. The gifts given to individuals are "the service of instruction, preaching, as well as the spiritual and corporal works of mercy: a brilliant flash of wisdom or understanding, an heroic manifestation of faith, the power to heal or work miracles, to speak in tongues or interpret them, and the ability intuitively to discern spirits."

The most common gift a Catholic may hear about or see firsthand is the gift to speak in tongues. Often this Catholic with will encounter this gift in a charismatic/pentecostal group. This gift causes the individual to more fully practice their faith and feel God's presence in their everyday life. St. Paul states that the gift of tongues is only from the Holy Spirit if it benefits the Church and not only the individual. Also St. Paul states that the charism of speaking in tongues are the lowest of the charisms and that the gift or charisms of faith, hope, and charity are the highest. Speaking in tongues has a process in order to be understood properly and not cause confusion and chaos amongst the community.

Other personal graces also are attributed to the Spirit. They are called the gifts of the Holy Spirit. While charisms are for the entire community, the gifts of the Spirit only affect the recipient. Since the charisms are for the community they are ranked higher that the gifts. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety and fear of the Lord. These gifts allow for the soul to be "more sensitive to the divine inspirations that incline to action within the area of their respective competence(p. 79)." The Encyclical *Divinum Illud munus* by Pope Leo XIII mentions how the gifts may lead a person to the highest level of sanctity and are permanent and will only be more perfect in heaven.

A modern day catholic will not only be curious about the charisms and gifts but also the symbols of the Spirit. The symbol of water and a dove represent baptism cleansing the soul from blemish. Fire represents purity and holiness. A kiss because the Holy Spirit comes forth from the exchange of love between the Father and the Son. A seal, oil, and the finger of God are also symbols of the Holy Spirit. The Spirits, Gifts, Charisms and Symbols are some of the great ways a modern Catholic may come to understand the dynamic presence of the Holy Spirit.

The school office will be open from 8:00 a.m. until noon Monday - Thursday. The office will also be closed from July 3rd-6th.






