

From the Pastor's Desk



Vacation is a time when people are supposed to change the pace a bit, alter their routines, and take a mental break from the everyday world of schedules and work. It's a time to do and say something different. So we pack up our bags, corral the kids, and head for the mountains or Europe or the sandy beaches of the ocean.

That can be difficult for some, because some of us are addicted to the "stuff" of our lives, our routines, our work. I saw a cartoon not too long ago: a family of four on vacation is sitting on the beach. The father is working at his laptop, the mother is on the cell phone, the boy is playing a hand-held electronic game, and the girl is dancing to the music coming in through her headphones. A modern-day family vacation, thanks to the marvels of technology. Four disconnected people who carry their world and its burdens with them, never taking the opportunity to break out into something challenging and new.

I want to take the notion of vacation and expand it to a larger notion of time apart, of spiritual time apart. We can use the example of arranging a "little room" of hospitality, as the woman did for the prophet Elisha in today's first reading.

Like Elisha, we all need a little room to go to once in awhile, a place where we can step back from the rat race, refresh our vision, and perhaps tackle significant questions about our life.

My suggestion is that this year, you spend as much time and energy on planning a retreat for yourself as you do in planning a vacation. Make plans to get away for a few days of spiritual renewal and personal reassessment. In a word, show some hospitality to yourself. Go away to that little room. The rewards will be great. In the first reading, recall what the prophet promised the lady: "This time next year you will be fondling a baby son." This is a symbolic way of saying that in return for your hospitality, for the time you have spent apart, you will find yourself embracing new life. And that is the best reward of all.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled week.





Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

What is the Elijah Cup?

The purpose of the Elijah Cup, a chalice, used during the Consecration of the Mass, is to provide a focal point for prayer. We are all aware of the need for vocations to the priesthood, the permanent diaconate and to the religious life. But sometimes we forget just how powerful praying for an increase in vocations can be. If we pray with the faith of the widow of Zarapeth, our cup will never run dry! We will always have priests to bring us Jesus in the Eucharist.



Interested families or individuals should contact Fr Gerald Walsh, or the Parish office to schedule a month to take the Elijah Cup home. At the end of Mass, (the second weekend of the month, usually the 9:30 am Family Mass) the Elijah Cup will be presented to the family or individual by a Deacon or Priest. The family will then take the cup home, putting it in a place of honor. Each day for a month, during prayer time (morning, bedtime or at meals), the family will pray for an increase and perseverance of vocations. The Elijah Cup should be brought back the second weekend of the month so it can be presented to a new family.

ELECTRONIC GIVING FORM

Our Electronic Giving program assures a continuation of your support even when you are not here. We encourage all of our parishioners to seriously consider utilizing this program. Most of us find that we attend Mass at parishes other than Prince of Peace during the year, related to vacations, family events, etc. We have received positive comments from parishioners who already utilize this program such as, "this makes it so much easier" and "I have peace of mind knowing that when I am out of town my obligations have been met."
