

From the Pastor's Desk



"Come to me all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest". To me, these words are among the loveliest and most hopeful words in Holy Scripture.

As we all know, life can be very burdensome for people - even for the wealthiest. There are all kinds of burdens - worry, bitterness, guilt, illness, disappointments, unemployment, difficult relationships, addictions, etc.

As we know, during the years that Jesus lived in Nazareth, he lived as an ordinary man among ordinary people - people just like you and me. He saw the Scribes and Pharisees live a privileged existence and lord it over the common folk. They had no understanding at all of what life was like for ordinary people. They emphasized only the Law of Moses and didn't give a hoot about extenuating circumstances. In fact, they even added hundreds more of their own rules and regulations to add to the people's burdens. And, to top it off, these 'holy men' had very little, if any, sympathy for those who found their burdens too much to bear.

Jesus, personally, saw all this first-hand. He was fully aware of the struggles and frustrations that the ordinary people had to endure. He was very aware of the heavy burdens that life placed on their shoulders. Consequently, Jesus felt deeply for these people and wanted to lighten their loads. People came to him from all walks of life and from very far distances with their burdens of sickness and misery. All of them had their burdens lightened by Jesus. His mere presence could bring peace to an anguished soul.

And, you know what, Jesus still can. I know that it will sound corny, but only with love can Jesus help us and help us lighten the burdens of other people. Only love can make a heavy load seem light.

There is a Zen story about an old man who walked around all day with a heavy bag on his back. On his deathbed, he passed this bag on to a disciple. When the disciple opened the bag, he found out that it was completely empty. So, he asked the old man why it weighed so much. And the old man said, "It is the weight of everything in my life that I did not need to carry".

Following Jesus should not make life more burdensome. If Jesus placed any burden on us at all, it was the burden of loving one another. That's all - nothing more. Jesus doesn't always take our burdens away from us but he does give us the strength to bear them. While faith makes all things possible, love makes all things easy.
