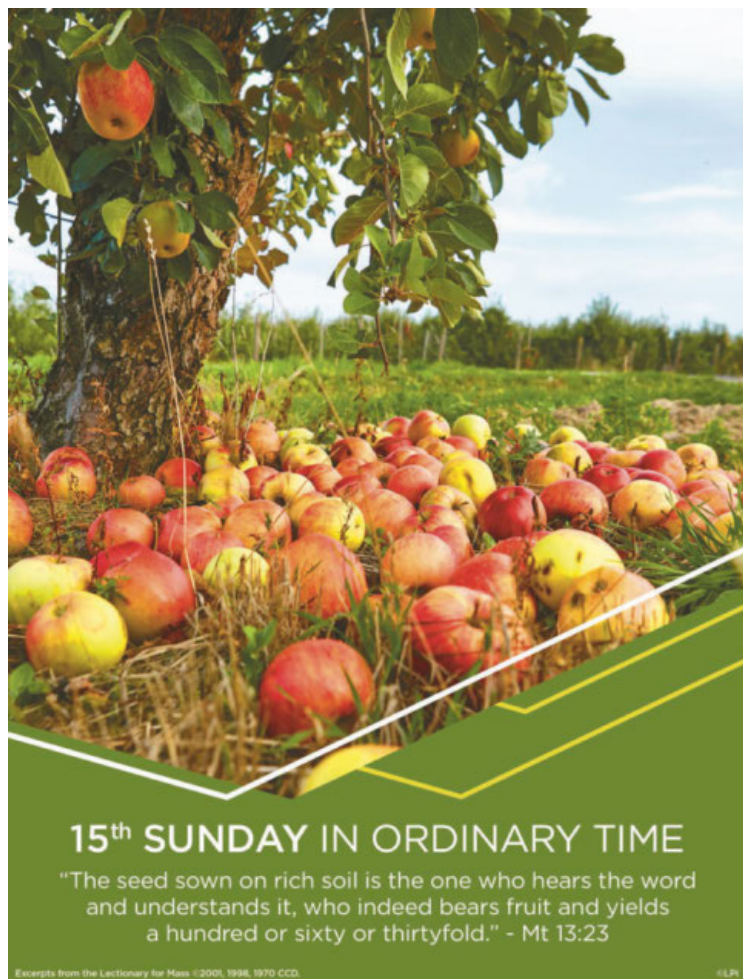

From the Pastor's Desk



In the Middle Ages, the monks, like most of the population, could not read. Every morning, they would meet in the chapel in front of a huge Bible. In silence they would listen while a literate monk read a single passage out loud. He would step back after his short reading, bow, and retire in silence. Then he would get up and read again, the same passage. And this he did over and over again until the chapel was empty. The idea was that as each monk got something out of the reading to take with him during the day, he would leave. As the Word invaded his life, he was ready for life. The Word had power. (Today we refer to this as Lectio Divina)

I mention this because today's Gospel we have heard many times, and hopefully as we listen to it this weekend, the Word invades our life a little differently than maybe when we have heard it a previous time.

This week's parable is of the farmer. The farmer is Jesus. The seed is God's word. The seed beds - path, rock, thorns, good soil - refer to the people who hear God's word. Some people reject it outright. Others receive it, and reject it later. Still others receive, treasure it, and put it into practice. It is important to note that in only one case was the word rejected outright. In the other two cases it was received with joy. The problem is not receiving God's word. The problem is in treasuring it and putting it into practice.

There are, therefore, three steps involved in responding to God's word: receiving it, treasuring it, and practicing it. The first step is hearing God's word. It involves listening attentively to the Scripture being read and explained. The second step is treasuring God's word. It involves taking to heart the word we have just heard. We consider its implications for our life and how it can make our life better. This second step doesn't necessarily take place in church. It may start in church, but it usually continues during the week ahead, as we think about the word we heard on Sunday. The third step is putting God's word into practice. It involves acting on what our mind has received and what our heart has treasured.

We not only need to listen to God's word but we also need to listen to each other. If someone listens to us as if we matter to them we feel valued. This is how Christ listens to us and how we need to listen to him, and listen to him not only in our prayers but as he speaks through others. By this caring we nurture the seed of his love. And if our soil is thin, we can fertilize it by prayer, by a kind word or act, by our sorrow for our own misdeeds. By paying attention to the ordinary goings on in our day to day, will we nourish God's life within us.

We know that God comes in the great events of our lives, but He also comes in the ordinary. He is there in our friend and our neighbor and every time we acknowledge his presence we deepen the soil, and give sustenance to the living word of God. He is the sower, the seed and the food for its growth. The harvest will take care of itself.

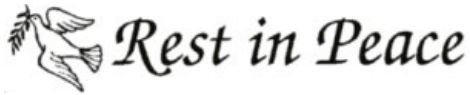

Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a “Donate” button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.



You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.

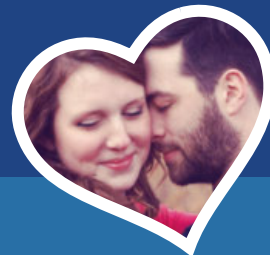

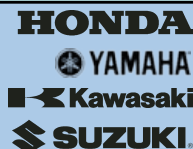

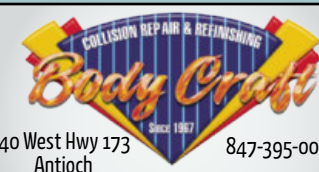
