

From the Desk of Deacon James Even



I, along with a few brave catechists, recently completed a week-long course on The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. The intended goal is to start an Atrium here at Prince of Peace (if you know what I am talking about and would like to help, let me know, if not here is a link for some more information - https://www.cgsusa.org/).

Of course, as I have found with anything relating to the meeting of God with children, what I originally expected and what I actually took away from the class were two very different things - the latter being far more powerful than I could imagine - because it was the simplest of

things; a sort of "no duh" moment.

This may come as a surprise to you all (it certainly was to me at the time), but God knows how to talk to children! In fact, we as adults tend to get in the way of their conversation as though we somehow know better than God how to teach our children about Him. Our job, according to CGS, should be to introduce the child to Jesus, then let them be.

Children this age have very little experience and knowledge to get in the way of their exploration of something new and they also have an incredible capacity for love and a desire for relationship, and when they are then introduced to God's word (and especially the parables) they are more open to it and "hear" so much clearer.


So, as a catechist, rather than asking the kids leading questions and expecting "the right" answers, we instead read the Word and then say "I wonder what Jesus meant when He said..." and then let them wonder. The instructor for our class gave many incredible examples of this method in action, and as convinced as I was by them, I still had to try it for myself. So I did.

In Vacation bible camp, we have been celebrating the miracles of Jesus and on Tuesday we focused on the wedding at Cana, one of my favorites because I know a lot about it, so I decided to use the "I wonder..." method when questioning the kids about it.

I told them that Jesus changed something like 180 gallons of water into the finest wine for the wedding party. And then I asked them "I wonder what Jesus could be showing us in doing that?" In my head I had an answer - the wine as a symbol of joy, the wedding as the covenant between God and his people - that Jesus was bringing back the joy to that relationship, etc. But rather than tell them, I just bit my tongue and waited.

And a little guy in the front row raised his hand and said - "Jesus did that so He could invite everyone to the party." Something so simple and yet right on point - I had now experienced it for myself and I look forward to learning even more from the smallest in our parish...





THE CASE FOR JESUS

Lecto: The Case for Jesus with Dr. Brant Pitre

Gospel accounts of Jesus's Crucifixion, Resurrection, and the proclamation of Christ's divinity.

This Bible Study will begin Thursday, September 7 at 7:00 pm at Prince of Peace Church. There will be 10 - 1 ½ hr. weekly sessions which include an introduction/ orientation to the class and nine sessions which include a video presentation along with discussion based on questions and reflections in the accompanying workbook.
