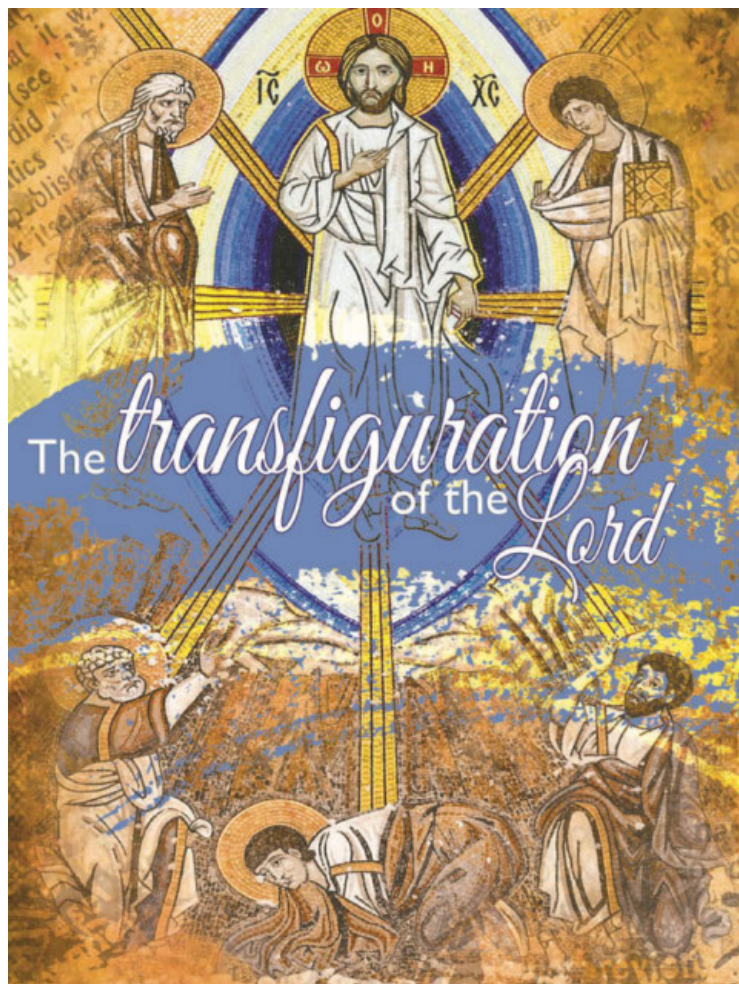

From the Pastor's Desk



We live in such a fast paced world today, and we can get caught up in a lot of commotion.

Some of you have been to the Major seminary, St Mary of the Lake in Mundelein. It's beautiful. There is almost a thousand acres of trees, fields, and a lake. When I was in seminary what I saw was the classrooms, the library, it seemed I was always running from place to place, meeting to meeting. Kind of like what I feel here during a busy week.

But once every two weeks I would take a walk (not run) with my spiritual director around the lake. I noticed things that I never noticed before. I saw the trees, heard the birds, and talked and prayed with my spiritual director. I underwent a transformative experience because of the presence of another.

We have experiences like these as well, experiences that enable us to perceive more definitively, to feel more sincerely, and to recognize more clearly the presence of the One who loves us - the presence of God. Experiences like these are like doors opening to the holy. And they are not as few and far between as we might think. We need only pay attention and realize that no matter where we are, we are in the company of the holy.

Jesus knew what it was like to be running around. He had fled his home town because his old neighbors wanted to kill him. His cousin John had been beheaded. The people in Galilee only wanted him if they could multiply bread. His disciples liked the glory of being with a miracle worker.

So what did he do? He went up the mountain to pray and he took Peter, James and John for support. He poured out his heart and fears in prayer.

We all need mountain-top experiences to get us over the bad times. They may be as dramatic as Jesus' transfiguration, or a tiny whispering sound, a walk with a spiritual director. God may rejuvenate us through an unusual prayer experience or through the carrying word of a friend.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled week.

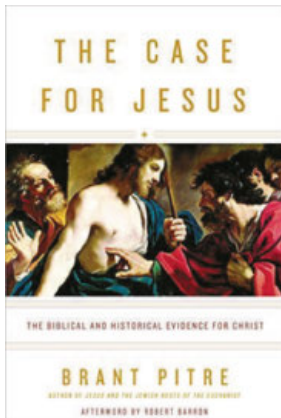

Lectio: The Case for Jesus with Dr. Brant Pitre



Do you follow Jesus 'on the way'? Can we trust the Gospels? Do we really know who wrote them?

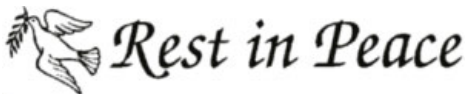
Do the Gospels communicate truth - or fabricated fables? Who is Jesus? Who did Jesus claim to be?

Join Dr. Brant Pitre as he draws evidence from both early Christian and non-Christian writings attesting to the authenticity, authorship, and dating of the Gospels, and as he gives an in-depth look at the Gospel accounts of Jesus' Crucifixion, Resurrection, and the proclamation of Christ's divinity.

Dr. Pitre's powerful presentation will strengthen your faith so that you can not only stand firm and profess that Jesus truly is "the Christ, the Son of the living God," but also confidently respond to any skeptics you encounter.

This Bible Study will begin Thursday, September 7 at 7:00 p.m. at Prince of Peace Church. There will be 10 - 1 1/2 hr. weekly sessions which include an introduction/orientation to the class and 9 sessions which include a video presentation along with discussions based on questions and reflections in the accompanying workbook.

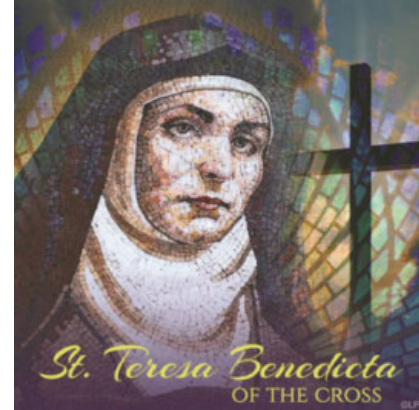

What is the Elijah Cup?

The purpose of the Elijah Cup, a chalice, used during the Consecration of the Mass, is to provide a focal point for prayer. We are all aware of the need for vocations to the priesthood, the permanent diaconate and to the religious life. But sometimes we forget just how powerful praying for an increase in vocations can be. If we pray with the faith of the widow of Zarephath, our cup will never run dry! We will always have priests to bring us Jesus in the Eucharist.



Background

In 1 Kings 17, during a drought, Elijah tells the poor widow of Zarephath that if she makes him a small loaf of bread with the last of her flour and oil, her "jar of flour will not go empty, nor the jug of oil run dry, until the Lord sends rain upon the earth." In faith, the widow baked the bread and fed Elijah. For the next year, the widow, her son, and Elijah ate bread made from the bowl of flour and jug of oil.

How does it work?

Each month, a family, a couple, or individual, has the opportunity to bring a chalice that has held the Consecrated Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ into their homes. The Elijah Cup serves as a focal point encouraging family prayer for religious vocations, for seminarians and for our serving religious. It is a powerful presence and inspires prayer from adults and children alike.

A Focal Point of Prayer for Vocations

Praying for vocations is the most powerful way to support God's call to religious life. A vocation is a call from the Holy Spirit, a gift from God that is nurtured through prayer. When we pray for vocations, we lift up to our Father those men and women He is calling in a very special way. We hope that those who bring the cup home will continue to pray for vocations daily.

Interested families or individuals should contact Fr Gerald Walsh, or the Parish office to schedule a month to take the Elijah Cup home. At the end of Mass, (the second weekend of the month, usually the 9:30 am Family Mass) the Elijah Cup will be presented to the family or individual by a Deacon or Priest. The family will then take the cup home, putting it in a place of honor. Each day for a month, during prayer time (morning, bedtime or at meals), the family will pray for an increase and perseverance of vocations. The Elijah Cup should be brought back the second weekend of the month so it can be presented to a new family.

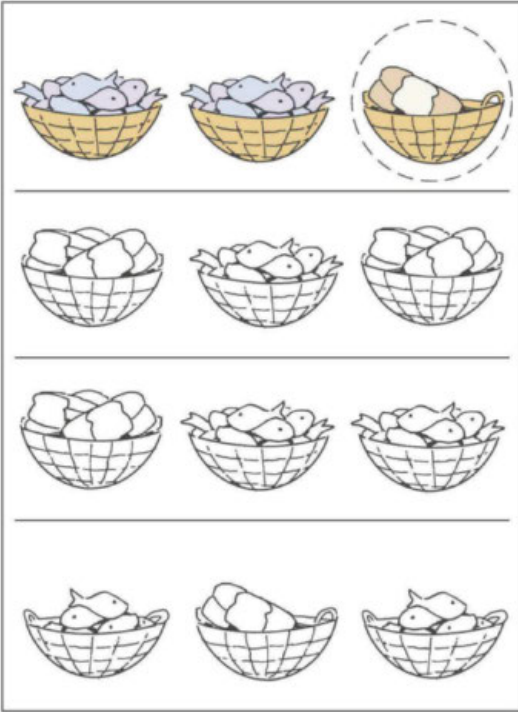

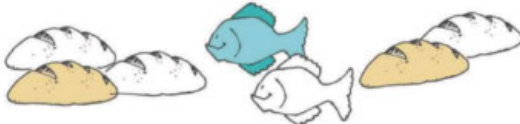

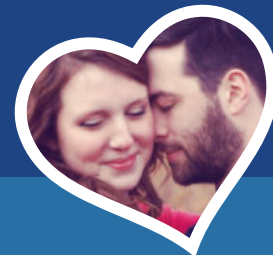
