

# From the Pastor's Desk



How can we find God, like Elijah did, in the quiet of a whisper, especially if it requires quiet? The Joseph Cardinal Bernardin gave us some insight in his book *The Gift of Peace*. He said, "Lord, I know that I spend a certain amount of that morning hour of prayer daydreaming, problem-solving, and I'm not sure that I can cut that out. I'll try, but the important thing is, I'm not going to give that time to anyone else. So even though it may not unite me as much with you as it should, nobody else is going to get that time." Even a Cardinal has trouble with being quiet.

I wonder if Elijah would have preferred to find God in the "strong and heavy wind," the "earthquake" or the "fire." The frightened prophet was hoping for a powerful God who could stand up for him. We can understand why Elijah might have wanted more than a whisper showing God's presence and concern. Some days we just want an earthquake to get things moving, a blazing fire to purge the surrounding and pervasive evil, or a powerful wind to topple the opposition to needed change. What we most often get it seems, is this Elijah-type God, who can't be manipulated to our expectations; who doesn't show up at our timing or according to our ordering. We learn that we are not in charge. We will just have to pay attention to this God who, though difficult to discern at times, is nevertheless present and invested in us.

This is a God who is quite accustomed to whispers and can hear our own prayers amid tears, our sighs of grief, and our groans of disappointments. A soft-spoken God is an appropriate companion when life is tumultuous. Sometimes it is only after a frantic and distressful period that we can look back at recent events and realize God was there all the time with us. It turns out, although, that the "whispering sound" of God may be hard to hear.

Is it possible for us to hear God in our society if hearing requires quiet time? TV, radio, cell phones, computers, prevent us from having quiet time. To hear God speak to us, we must be listening. Often when I am looking for inspiration for my homily, I have to turn off the distractions. If I wore a set of headphones and listened to music, I would be tuning out God. We sometimes want to tune out other things around us, but we don't want to be so effective that we tune out God also.

How can we plan to have quiet time to discern our God? Not having a plan is, in fact a plan, but not a very good one. How about spending a certain amount of time each day in prayer, as did Joseph Cardinal Bernardin? One very effective way of listening to God at Prince of Peace occurs here 6 days a week in adoration. Often, I see moms and dads sitting in there with their eyes closed soaking up the presence of God.

Going on a retreat is another way to get away from it all. One can go for part of a day, a whole day, a weekend, or even a week. You can make either a private or directed retreat. There are few retreat centers within a few hour drive from the parish. Two retreat centers are very close, within 20 minutes, one being Marytown in Mundelein, and the other is Benet Lake with the Benedictine Monks. God whispers to us. Will we be quiet and listen to him?

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled week.







# **Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?**

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.







