## ***From the Associate Pastor's Desk***



### **Fraternal Correction**

**How would we go about fraternally correcting someone and why would we even try?**

In this weekend's Gospel we hear Jesus say to his disciples: "If your brother sins against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone. If he listens to you, you have won over your brother..." If your brother listens to you great, if not, then bring another person to establish the facts and go tell them directly. If that does not work, tell the church maybe bring some of the good reputable families of the church and go tell them directly. If that does not work treat them like tax collectors and sinners.

Usually we might think it is time to fraternally correct someone if we notice that they are committing a sin or causing harm to themselves or others (especially us). The person has hurt us others or themselves by their behaviors and it is time for some correcting so they stop. First thing we have to ask ourselves is why do we want to correct this person. If the reason is to scold, judge, put down, yell at, be nasty, belittle, hurt or make ourselves feel better we may need to take a breather, pause and think if we are in the right place to fraternally correct.

St Francis needed to do some fraternal correction with another brother but he was not quite ready yet because he did not love him enough. St. Francis knew his correcting had to come from a place of great love, if not he would not be trying to stop the sinful behavior he would potentially hurt the other person in the name of a 'virtuous' and 'holy' act. The hope is that we want the other person to stop hurting us, others and themselves and maybe even restore the relationship we have with them.

One of the hardest things in life are conflicts and how to address them. Someone has hurt us and the temptation is not to go to them directly and try to start the process of fraternal correction, but to tell others how bad that person is and what they did to us. We share the story because we are hurt or possibly mad at the other person. We may even want to harm the reputation of the other person. What ends up happening is that everyone one else knows about how bad that person is and what they have done to us however, the person who has hurt us might not know they have hurt us or what they are doing is hurtful. Also another consequence is that everyone who hears this hurtful quality may come to the conclusion that this 'hurtful' person is like that with everyone and even with them. Now this 'sinful' person has a potential bad reputation with others and is not reconciled with the person they hurt. We may never receive peace, reconciliation, and healing just getting to share the same story over and over again to whomever will still listen to it.

What if the person who was hurt, with great love started the process of fraternal correction? Best case scenario is that the hurtful person did not realize they hurt the other or did not mean to be hurtful. What if the hurtful person humbly takes the correction and starts changing that behavior. Fraternal correction is hard but if we do it with great love, great results are possible.

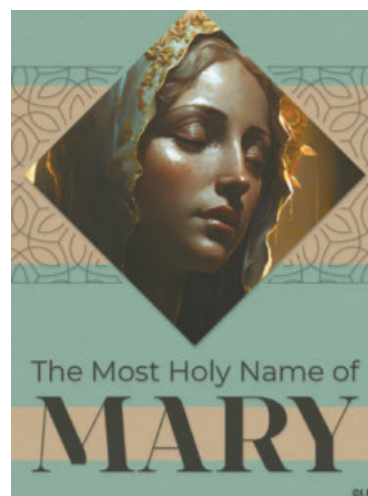

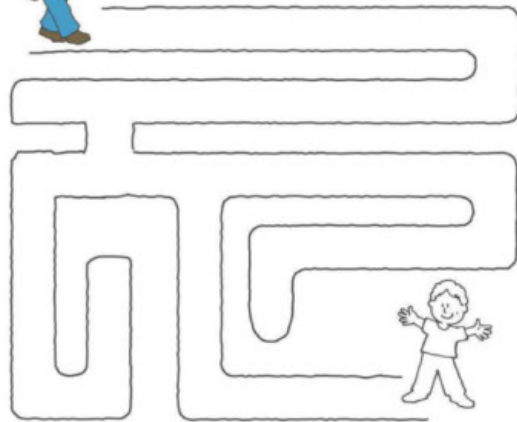

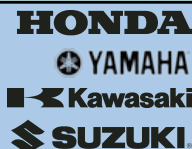
