

#### From the Pastor's Desk



Did you ever wish you could get more out of the Mass? For many Catholics the Mass might, at least in a certain sense, be almost too familiar. We show up to church each Sunday and perform prayers and rituals that many of us have known since childhood.

Learning more about the Mass is well worth our time and effort. For the Mass has been at the very center of Christian worship since the time of the apostles. It is the celebration of the Eucharist that Jesus instituted at the Last Supper. So important is the Mass that Vatican

Il called it "the source and summit" of the Christian life. On one hand, our entire lives are directed toward the Mass; and on the other hand, as Christians we find the spiritual strength, guidance, and support we need to live our regular daily lives from the Mass.

As we do this, we are reminded that there are two groups of people who are important. The first are all of us, the community of people who come together to do as Jesus invited us to when He said "do this as a remembrance of me". We do not come to watch someone else as if we were attending a performance. Instead, we actively and wholeheartedly are part of the prayer of the Mass. It is in us that the life of Jesus and the work of our salvation unfolds. We are the Body of Christ. The closer we are to Christ, the more we manifest Christ to others. The second is our priest who stands in the place of Christ, as our pastor, friend, and spiritual leader. He teaches us and nourishes us when we gather. In everything we are united as one with Christ, the "source and summit" of who we are. A priest is chosen from the community and ordained by the Sacrament of Holy Orders to make the gift of the Eucharist possible. Through our priests, Christ acts. Christ is the Good Shepherd, the Prince of Peace.

The Weekend of October 21 and 22, we will journey together through a "Teaching Mass". Before we begin our journey, it will be helpful to have a brief overview of the itinerary we will follow, which is an outline of the Mass itself: the Introductory Rites, the Liturgy of the Word, the Liturgy of the Eucharist, and the Concluding Rites. The two principal parts of the Mass are: the Liturgy of the Word and the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

I am hoping that this opportunity will help us encounter Our Lord more deeply in the liturgy itself. By understand the meaning of what we say and do in the Mass, we will be better prepared to give ourselves to Jesus in every prayer and gesture in the Liturgy.

Knowing more about the Mass, we can be closer to Christ and to the miracles He left us on that Holy Thursday night.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled week.





## **Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?**

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.



"Radical solidarity compels us to come alongside vulnerable mothers in profound friendship, compassion, and support for both them and their preborn children. It requires us to address the fundamental challenges that lead an expectant mother

to believe she is unable to welcome the child God has entrusted to her. We must do all we can to provide mothers, children, and families with the support they need to flourish. This cannot be accomplished by laws or policy alone, but requires the continual transformation of our own hearts.









