

From the Desk of Deacon James Even



Why do we have our Confirmation in the Fall? This is a question I have been asked at least once a year for the last six years at least, and one that I love to answer, because there is more to it than one may think...

Of course, there is a very practical reason we host it in the Fall; many of the parishes around us have theirs in the Spring, so to avoid the competition and be almost 100% assured of getting our first choice of bishop and weekend is much greater in the Fall.

However - this is not all of it, nor the most important part of it...

Timing is everything. Everything that we do when it comes to the sacramental rites and liturgy has a meaning; every motion, every sound, every word speaks to something deeper going on behind it and that even includes the days and times we celebrate.

For instance, the Nativity of St John the Baptist is celebrated on June 24th - six months prior to Jesus' birth because for one, the scriptures tell us so (see Lk. 1:26). But something even greater is going on behind the scenes as well; the date of the feast also happens to be close to an important meteorological day in the northern hemisphere - the summer solstice - the longest day of the year and the beginning of our descent to the darkness of winter as the days get shorter and the nights longer.

St John was the last of the Old Testament prophets, a bridge between the Old and the New, and he embodied the closing of an age - a decreasing so that another greater than he could increase - and we see that mirrored in the heavens as the daylight retreats to the night until, around the longest night of the year, The Light enters the world at the birth of Jesus, and the days begin to get longer...

Likewise, the time of year we choose to celebrate a sacrament can point to a greater meaning beyond it. Confirmation has taken on the charism of a graduation of sorts and is seen more often than not as a rite of passage into adulthood in the Catholic Church and a graduation from formal religious education. While it may not be the entire reason for the misconception, celebrating Confirmation in the Spring - a time when graduations and school years end- at the least further underscores it.

At Jesus' Baptism and what follows (see MT 3:13 - 4:11), we see what is truly happening in the sacrament. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, Jesus heads off into the world to be tempted in all the ways that we can be tempted, and does not give in, does not sin. This does not point to an ending but rather a beginning, a strengthening for the journey, arming us for the spiritual battle that we will face walking in His Way and living our Faith in a fallen world.

And this is why we have Confirmation Mass in the Fall - a time where most of those receiving the sacrament are beginning something new, heading out into a new world and the unknown with the strength given to them by the Gifts of the Holy Spirit to live the Faith they have spent these years learning and growing in.

So congratulations to all of our newly Confirmed; may you always be aware of the Gifts you have received in this sacrament and, strengthened by them, be guided through this life, to life everlasting.

We Are a Resurrection People By Deacon Jim

As we get closer to the month of November, we enter a time when the Church remembers those who have gone before us in faith. First we remember those who we have canonized saints and then November 2nd, we remember our faithful departed. First and foremost, we remember them through our prayers. These can be individual prayers for those who have died in our families and among our friends. And we also gather as parish community to remember those in our parish family who have died this past year, as well as those who are grieving a loss. We commend those who have died to God's loving care while at the same time allowing ourselves to feel the support of our parish family.

As a part of that parish family, it important to know that everyone is invited to our parish All-Souls Liturgy on November 2nd at 7:00 pm. We can help let those who grieve know they are not alone during this difficult time.

We also invite you to write the names of those who have died in the last year in the Book of the Dead which will be displayed in church.

Finally, as we have done the last few years, once again we invite you to bring in pictures of your loved ones who have gone before us. They will be placed on the sanctuary steps and can be dropped off at the parish office. We do ask that you please put some identifying label on the back of the picture so that we can make sure they are returned to you. The pictures will be available for pick up during the following weekend's Masses (November 4, 5).

Also, before the All-Soul's Mass, we will show a slide show of pictures of our beloved dead. If you have a digital picture you'd like to include, please forward it to minor@princeofpeacelv.org. If you have submitted a digital photo in the past, there is no need to re-submit. We will use the one from the previous years.

Grieving the loss of a loved one can be a difficult time for everyone. The value of a support system within a parish allows those experiencing grief to not grieve alone. Here at Prince of Peace, there might be those who have had time to process their grief as well as those who have just recently experienced a loss. Wherever you may be in the grief experience, know that the parish is here to support you. God is present in your loss. We are available to help through individual appointments, grief support groups here at the parish and through referrals to other resources. If you are struggling in any way, please do not hesitate to contact us.

The Results are in!

Several months ago, Prince of Peace participated in a parish-wide survey, the Disciple Maker Index. The results are in!

More than 164 of our parishioners completed the survey. Those numbers compare favorably with the other participating parishes.

A more detailed analysis of the complete survey results will be released from time-to-time as we continue to unpack the data and discern its implications.

Disciple Maker Index Snapshot

- · 87% of respondents would recommend Prince of Peace to others!
- · 82% feel that Prince of Peace is a welcoming community!
- · 100% would recommend the religious education program here at Prince of Peace!

The responses are very encouraging and highlight some opportunities for growth. It is a good snapshot of how things are going here at POP.

The leadership team would like to thank all of you who took the time to participate in the Disciple Maker Index survey. It is an important piece of the puzzle to help us in sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ and forming Missionary Disciples.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.



A Prayer for Vocations:

Heavenly Father, Your divine Son taught us to pray to the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into His vineyard. 
