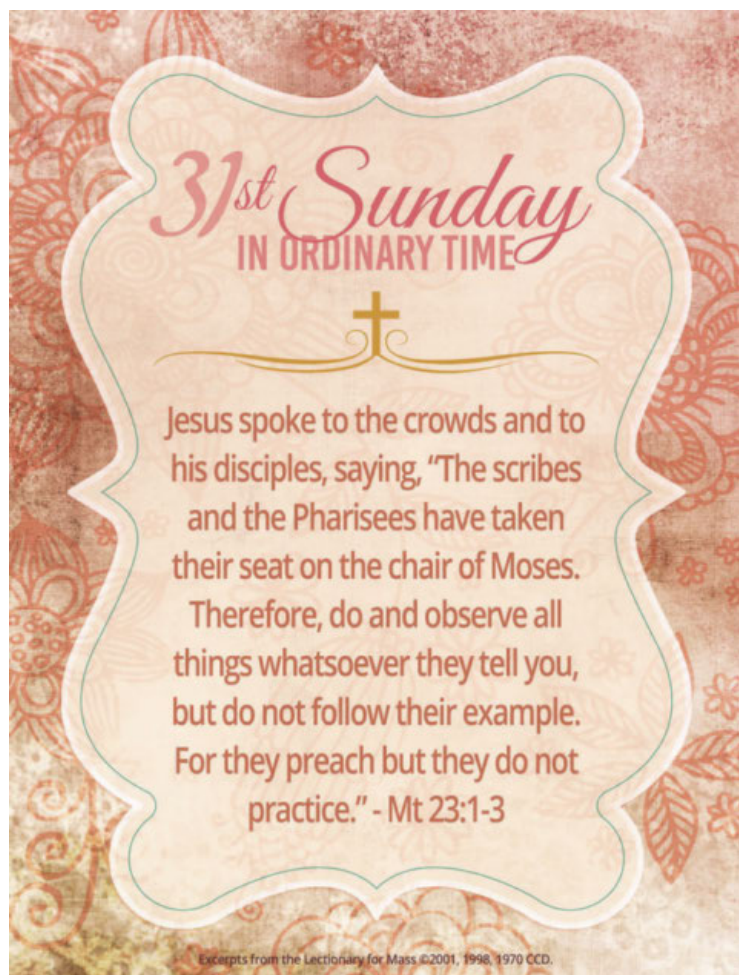

## ***From the Pastor's Desk***



Last week your doorbell probably rang and standing in front of you where little children saying "Trick or Treat". Children love Halloween because they like to pretend. God has given them huge imaginations and with a little cloth here, some make-up or a mask they can be anyone their mind tells them they are.

Putting on a mask and pretending is perfectly acceptable for a child. Putting on a mask and pretending is not acceptable for a follower of Jesus Christ. God is not satisfied with people imagining that they are great followers of Christ. We are not called to appear to be a holy people. We are called to really be a holy people.

In the gospel Jesus gives the example of the Pharisees. He says they wear all the holy costumes, headbands and tassels in front of their eyes containing inscriptions from scripture. (The reason why they did that is because in scripture God says, "Keep my words always before your eyes.") So, when the Pharisees moved their heads, they would see the words of scripture, thereby keeping God's words before their eyes.

According to Jesus, we could say these Pharisees went trick or treating to all the important banquets so that everyone else could see them. That's all they really wanted. They were just putting on a show. They knew how to hold their arms up in prayer. They said the proper pious platitudes. They pretended to be holy, but they are not holy.

On the weekend after Halloween we are faced with some of the most frightening words in scripture. We are told to fight against our own hypocrisy. We cannot demand more from others than we demand from ourselves. We must take responsibility for our faith lives. We entrust our lives to God and God only. Only Christ can be our guide.

And that brings us right back to where we started. If we, you and I, can find the courage to let Jesus be our guide, if every aspect of our lives reflects the presence of Jesus in the world, then we would not be wearing masks, but would really and truly be followers of Christ.

Following Jesus is the serious work of people who are willing to expose their faces and their lives to the world. Halloween and make believe are for children.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled week.

### **What is the Elijah Cup?**

The purpose of the Elijah Cup, a chalice, used during the Consecration of the Mass, is to provide a focal point for prayer. We are all aware of the need for vocations to the priesthood, the permanent diaconate and to the religious life. But sometimes we forget just how powerful praying for an increase in vocations can be. If we pray with the faith of the widow of Zarephath, our cup will never run dry! We will always have priests to bring us Jesus in the Eucharist.



### **Background**

In 1 Kings 17, during a drought, Elijah tells the poor widow of Zarephath that if she makes him a small loaf of bread with the last of her flour and oil, her "jar of flour will not go empty, nor the jug of oil run dry, until the Lord sends rain upon the earth." In faith, the widow baked the bread and fed Elijah. For the next year, the widow, her son, and Elijah ate bread made from the bowl of flour and jug of oil.

### **How does it work?**

Each month, a family, a couple, or individual, has the opportunity to bring a chalice that has held the Consecrated Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ into their homes. The Elijah Cup serves as a focal point encouraging family prayer for religious vocations, for seminarians and for our serving religious. It is a powerful presence and inspires prayer from adults and children alike.

### **A Focal Point of Prayer for Vocations**

Praying for vocations is the most powerful way to support God's call to religious life. A vocation is a call from the Holy Spirit, a gift from God that is nurtured through prayer. When we pray for vocations, we lift up to our Father those men and women He is calling in a very special way. We hope that those who bring the cup home will continue to pray for vocations daily.

**Interested families or individuals should contact Fr Gerald Walsh, or the Parish office to schedule a month to take the Elijah Cup home. At the end of Mass, (the second weekend of the month, usually the 9:30 am Family Mass) the Elijah Cup will be presented to the family or individual by a Deacon or Priest. The family will then take the cup home, putting it in a place of honor. Each day for a month, during prayer time (morning, bedtime or at meals), the family will pray for an increase and perseverance of vocations. The Elijah Cup should be brought back the second weekend of the month so it can be presented to a new family.**
