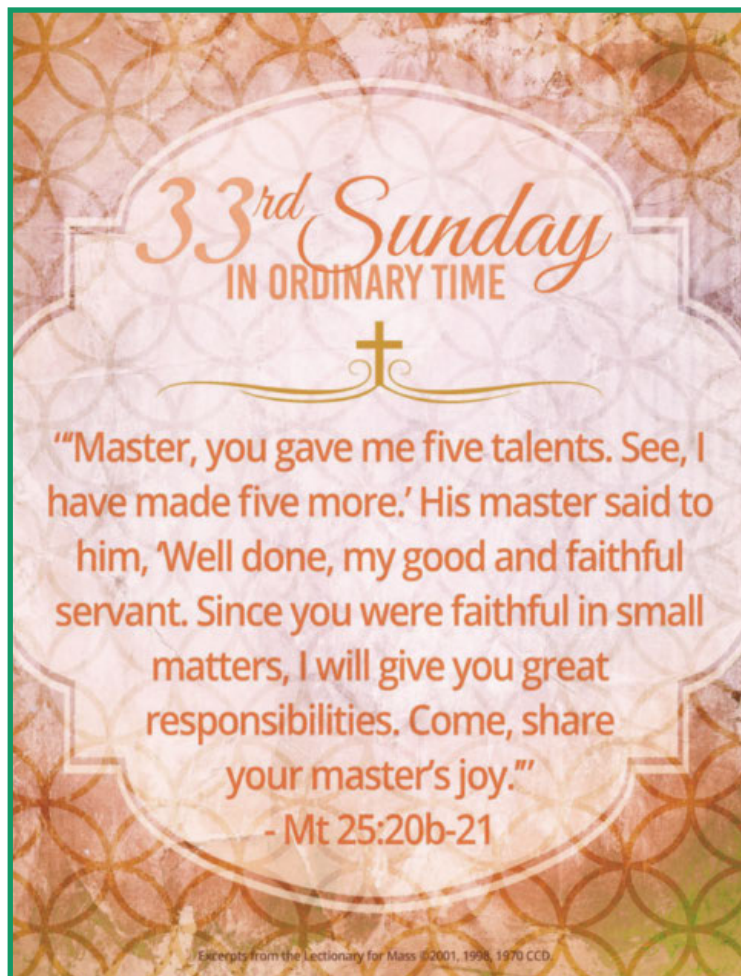

From the Pastor's Desk



What do you think would happen if each one of us suddenly became a more thankful person? If all of us suddenly became a more appreciative people?

All of us like to be appreciated, all of us like to be thanked, and all of us, I believe, like to see those we love live thankful lives, appreciative lives, so much so that we teach our children this virtue - at our dinner tables, - during birthday parties, - in the middle of visits from their grandparents, - and just about anytime that they are receiving something from someone or asking someone for something.

Giving thanks blesses the person who is thanked and it transforms the person who gives thanks. It works the same way everywhere, with everyone, even with God.

God wants us to celebrate his love. God wants us to give thanks in everything. God doesn't want this because He is greedy for praise, the Lord doesn't want it so that He will feel better about Himself, He wants it because it will bless us and because it will bless the world He has made. He wants us to remember what He has done - so that we will not be afraid when we are in need of help, and so that we will not grow arrogant or rude when we are prospering. He wants us to remember and give thanks to Him, and to those around us - so that our lives will be full of light and hope and so our actions full of tenderness and love.

As the psalmist declares in Psalm 92, "It is good to give thanks to the LORD, to sing praises to his name".

As we approach the celebration of Thanksgiving this week, I would like to take the opportunity to express my appreciation for your selfless stewardship of time, talent and treasure. We have been called together in this time and in this place to deepen our relationship with God and one another. Thank you for being part of the journey! I also ask that we take time during this holiday to pray for those who are most in need... spiritually and materially.

If you are traveling, may you be afforded safety and protection and know that we look forward to your arrival back home to Prince of Peace. As I travel to be with my brother and family in Lisle on Thanksgiving, be assured of my prayers and acknowledgement of your kindness.

And finally, if possible make Mass your first Thanksgiving event of celebration. Everything else you will do that day will be even more enjoyable because you were at Mass. Eucharist means first of all "Thanksgiving."

I hope that you enjoy a blessed Thanksgiving.

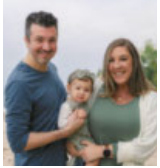

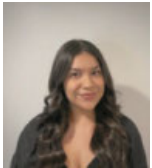

MORNING PRAYER FOR ADVENT

Advent is approaching and it is a time of preparation. We have a great way to prepare by joining us in Morning Prayer after Mass during the weeks of Advent.

Morning Prayer is part of the Liturgy of the Hours which are a series of prayers that have been offered daily by people for centuries. They are prayed at intervals of three hours from 3 am to 9 pm with Morning Prayer being the 6 am segment. The prayers usually take about 10 minutes and are a great way to recenter your day on God.

This prayer will be done utilizing the IBreviary App available for smartphones and tablets. It is available for free from both the Apple App Store and Google Apps. This app includes the Liturgy of the Word, the Missal and Readings for the Day, Prayers, and the Rites of the Church.

Deacon Mark will have a run through session on November 28th following the Morning Mass.

Please join us for this opportunity to participate in this ancient liturgy.

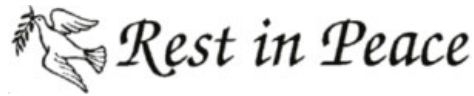

Catholic Charities Christmas Share Program 2023

Catholic Charities is preparing for the annual Christmas Gift Program. Last year, they provided gifts across Lake County for over 13,000 needy children. Their plans this year including returning their outreach to pre-COVID levels which means many more children will be able to benefit from the generosity of people, especially those from Prince of Peace.

Our Christmas Share program for Catholic Charities this year is a hybrid of both physical gifts and gift cards. Tickets for physical gifts are going to be available at Masses during Thanksgiving weekend and the weekend after. We also have tickets available in the parish office.

In addition, we also are offering people an option of purchasing gift cards instead of actual gifts. These cards can be purchased from Walmart, Target, Kohl's or any another store where you might have bought gifts in the past. We ask that whatever amount you would have spent on a gift in past years, be purchased for this year. Then along with the gift card, enclose a note specifying what age range you would like to purchase for. Catholic Charities will then go out and purchase the gifts. They will do the best they can to honor your request. The gift cards can then be placed in the collection basket or dropped off at the parish office.

All Donations (both physical gifts and gift cards) are due back the weekend of 12/ 9,10.

Also, we are in need of people willing to help sort and transport the gifts to the distribution facility on December 10th. We will begin sorting the morning of December 10th. The project is usually completed by 1:30-2:30 that afternoon. We are especially in need of vehicles with trailers to transport the bikes we receive. If you are able to help, please contact us here at the parish office or me through email at jminor@princeofpeaceclv.org.

Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a “Donate” button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.



You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.
