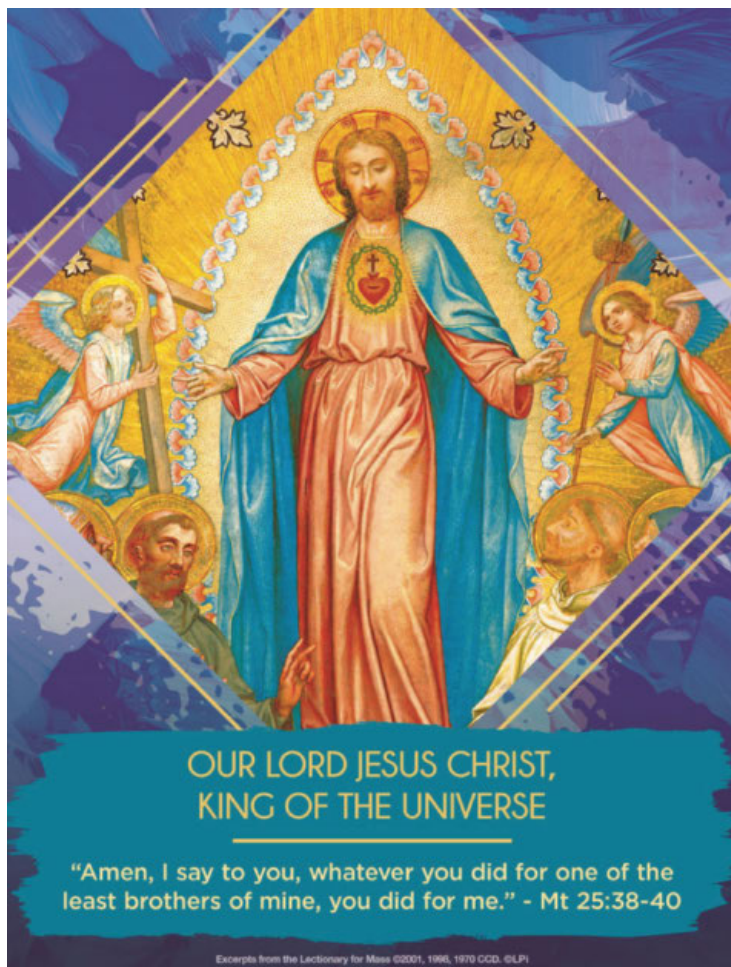

From the Desk of Deacon Mark Weiss

CHOICE



Today is the Feast of Christ the King and what an incredible King we have in Jesus. The Son of God humbled Himself to become human so that we could share in His divinity. The life that He lived was the example of what to expect of His kingdom.

He was not born in a palace with wealth and power, but in a stable with a feeding trough as His bed. His birth was not greeted with the rejoicing of the privileged, but by the Shepherds, some of the lowest people of that time.

He did not choose the Pharisees, Sadducees, or Scribes as His disciples, but fishermen and other people who were relative nobodies in society. He even choose a tax collector, a despised individual, to be one of His Apostles.

Jesus was criticized for eating with sinners, but they were the ones He wanted to reach. Once they became followers He expected them to carry on His compassion for those they came in contact with throughout their lives.

In today's Gospel He tells us how we will be judged when we come face-to-face with Him at our judgement. How have we lived our lives in accord with the example that He gave us?

We are told quite clearly that it is the way we treat other people that will determine our eternity. Did we follow the second great Commandment that He gave us, "Love your neighbor as yourself."

It is very easy to become self absorbed in our wants and become blind to the needs of the people around us. We see the poor, the addicted, those who ask for our help and we judge whether they are worthy to receive it. Sadly, it is very easy to find a reason to withhold our assistance. How often have we seen a beggar and ignored them, the lonely and failed to spend time with them, the unpopular and avoided them?

Our King will be gracious to those who treat His sons and daughters with compassion. It is not always easy, and at times we may fall short, but we must try. Woe to those who ignore the suffering of others.

The Kingdom of God is a kingdom of love and compassion. Those who will share in this kingdom must possess these traits here on Earth. They will place the needs of others before their wants. They will truly love their neighbor as themselves. The reward will be great.

I pray that we will, to the best of our ability, live up to what our King expects of us so that we may share an eternity with Him.

MORNING PRAYER FOR ADVENT

Advent is approaching and it is a time of preparation. We have a great way to prepare by joining us in Morning Prayer after Mass during the weeks of Advent.

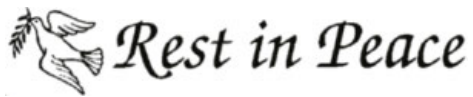
Morning Prayer is part of the Liturgy of the Hours which are a series of prayers that have been offered daily by people for centuries. They are prayed at intervals of three hours from 3 am to 9 pm with Morning Prayer being the 6 am segment. The prayers usually take about 10 minutes and are a great way to recenter your day on God.

This prayer will be done utilizing the IBreviary App available for smartphones and tablets. It is available for free from both the Apple App Store and Google Apps. This app includes the Liturgy of the Word, the Missal and Readings for the Day, Prayers, and the Rites of the Church.

Deacon Mark will have a run through session on November 28th following the Morning Mass.

Catholic Charities is preparing for the annual Christmas Gift Program. Last year, they provided gifts across Lake County for over 13,000 needy children. Their plans this year including returning their outreach to pre-COVID levels which means many more children will be able to benefit from the generosity of people, especially those from Prince of Peace.

Our Christmas Share program for Catholic Charities this year is a hybrid of both physical gifts and gift cards. Tickets for physical gifts are going to be available at Masses during Thanksgiving weekend and the weekend after. We also have tickets available in the parish office.

In addition, we also are offering people an option of purchasing gift cards instead of actual gifts. These cards can be purchased from Walmart, Target, Kohl's or any another store where you might have bought gifts in the past. We ask that whatever amount you would have spent on a gift in past years, be purchased for this year. The gift cards can then be placed in the collection basket or dropped off at the parish office.

All Donations (both physical gifts and gift cards) are due back the weekend of 12/ 9,10.

Also, we are in need of people willing to help sort and transport the gifts to the distribution facility on December 10th. We will begin sorting the morning of December 10th. The project is usually completed by 1:30-2:30 that afternoon. We are especially in need of vehicles with trailers to transport the bikes we receive. Please be advised that a number of parishioners have reported that they received fraudulent text messages from someone claiming to be "Rev Gerald G Walsh." This is part of a nationwide scam in which con artists impersonate priests or clergy with the intent to confuse, manipulate, and steal. The criminals send emails and texts to church members asking them to buy gift cards for fake charitable causes or for a friend of the priest. I will never contact a parishioner directly with an emergency request for cash or gift cards. Messages asking parishioners to help fulfill a need would come through Prince of Peace bulletins or announcements at Mass.

Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a “Donate” button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.



You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish.
