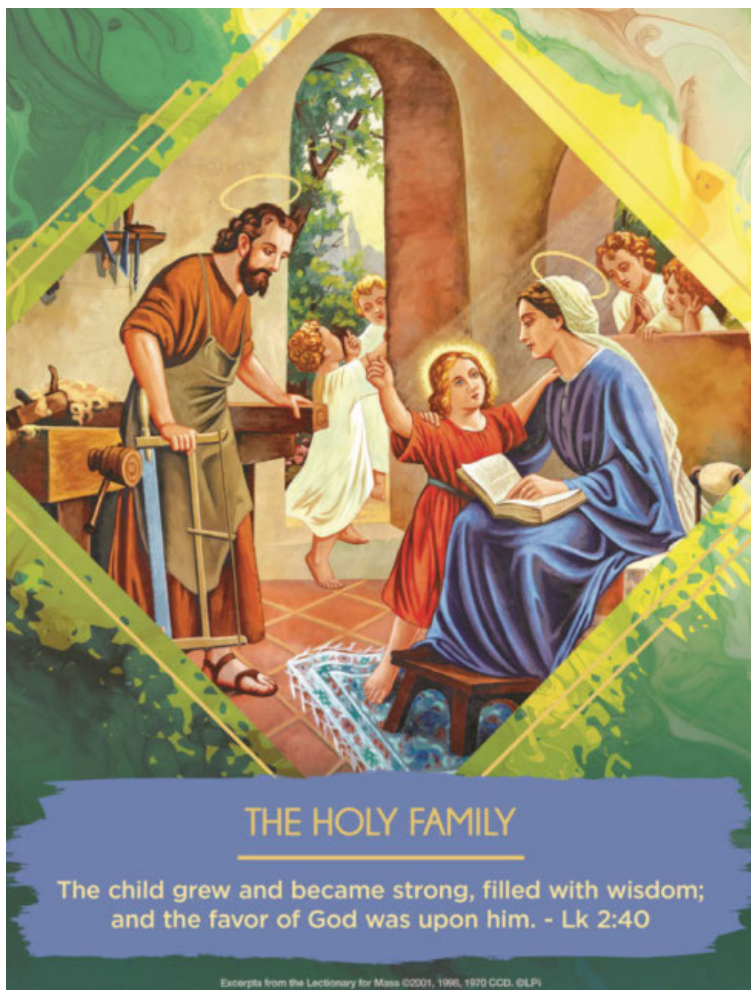

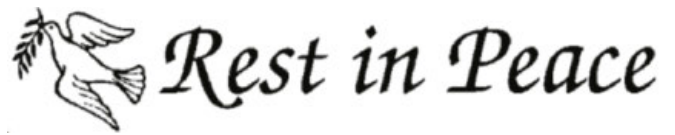

How To Practice Natural Family Planning

Over the past weeks we have shared an overview of Natural Family Planning and why it is both relevant and healthy for us to follow the Church's teaching on contraception. We'd encourage you to look back at the bulletin archives if you missed the first parts of this series.

Today we will share a bit about how Natural Family Planning works. In short, NFP works with the science of a woman's fertility. Below we highlight a couple of ways that fertility can be tracked, but there are many other signs that couples can use as well to gain a most complete picture.

As ovulation approaches, two different hormones come into play. Estrogen rises as a woman's body prepares for ovulation, signaling the beginning of the fertile window, which can last several days. Then, luteinizing hormone surges when ovulation is imminent. With modern technology, fertility monitors can easily track both of these hormone levels.

After ovulation, a woman's resting body temperature, or BBT, will noticeably rise due to a rise in progesterone. This can easily be tracked with BBT specific thermometers. In most cases, three days after a rise in temp marks the end of a fertile window. When practiced with fidelity, NFP is as effective, and in some cases more effective, than contraception.

And that's just the tip of the iceberg! We would encourage anyone interested in learning more to connect with us or register for an NFP class to learn everything you need to know to practice NFP. Our bodies, and our fertility, are wonderful gifts, and it is quite awe inspiring to understand what happens each month. Sadly, many women are never taught any of this unless they specifically seek out the information for themselves. It is often incredibly empowering to understand how our fertility works, and to choose to work with our fertility to plan our family vs. artificially suppressing a healthy part of ourselves.

We hope if you are curious to learn more, or if you have any questions, that you will feel free to reach out to us at any time.

- People recognize the love of Christ through one another.

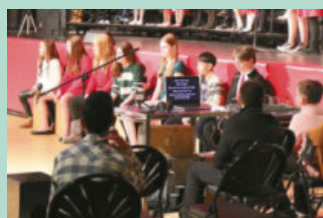
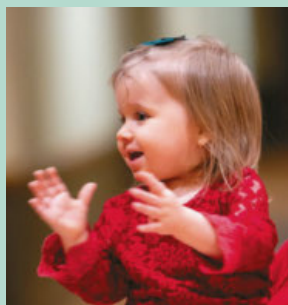

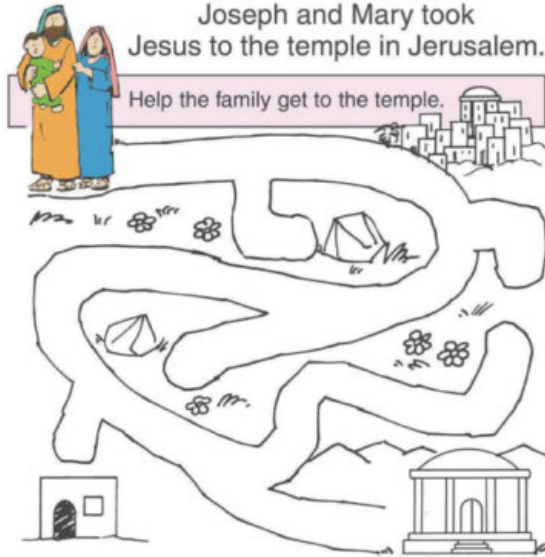

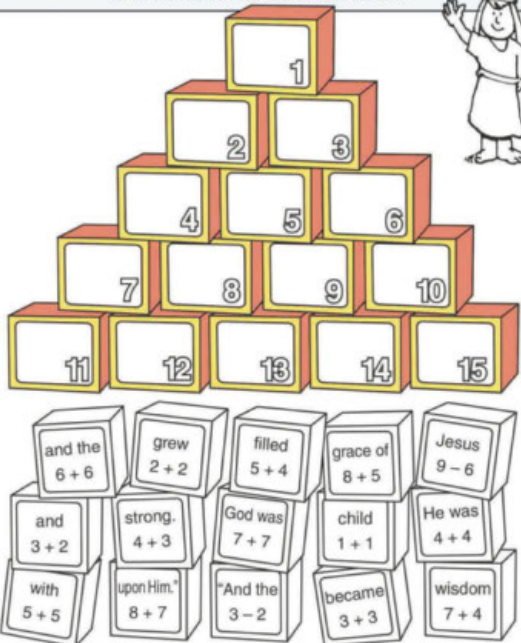
