From the Pastor's Desk



Our Gospel today tells of a leper who dared the unthinkable for someone in his condition. This man with leprosy approached Jesus, kneeling before our Lord, begging for a healing. He must have heard about the evil spirits Jesus had exorcised, or the various illnesses and maladies he had cured in Capernaum and the surrounding villages. At any rate, this “untouchable” crossed the line of isolation imposed upon him by the village, and risked it all on the chance that Jesus might be able and willing to heal him. And he was right.

Jesus met the leper’s unthinkable initiative with an unthinkable initiative of his own. Not only did Jesus heal the man, he did so by reaching out his hand and touched the leper - sores and deformities and stigma notwithstanding. Jesus dared to heal by touch. Of course, Jesus did not have to physically touch the leper to perform the healing. Several times in the Gospels Jesus heals illness merely by speaking the word, often at a great distance from the afflicted one. So why did Jesus touch this man? Precisely because everyone thought he was untouchable. No one should be treated as an outcast from society, either for physical, emotional, mental, or spiritual brokenness. Jesus shows us all another way. He came to show us a God who touches, and who can be touched; a God whose embrace is wider than we ever imagined; a God who suffers with us, and for us.

What a shock it must have been to the leper, and to those who witnessed this miracle, to see Jesus extend his hand across the man-made void separating this leper from his community. That act itself was a gift of grace. And then, Jesus urged the man not to tell anyone about the healing, instead he told the man to show himself to the priests as proof that he was indeed healed, as a prerequisite to restoration to the community. I am sure Jesus did not want this miracle to distract and interrupt his mission. And you would think that the former leper would obey such a direct command of the one who healed him. But amazingly he did just the opposite, he told the news to everyone, spreading the news openly to everyone who would listen.

Before we judge this man too harshly, let’s think about it. If we had been healed of a disease this terrible, could we keep silent about it? Wouldn’t we want to sing praises from the highest steeple, and shout it in the streets? Even though Jesus asked him not to tell, he just couldn’t help it. The news was just too good, and so transforming for him, that spreading the glad tidings proved too irresistible. And here is the question I find myself asking, “If this one could not resist telling others how much Jesus had changed his life, even defying a direct command from Jesus to keep quiet, how in the world am I so slow, so hesitant, and so embarrassed to tell others about my Lord? How do I keep quiet when the news is this good?” It is news too good to keep quiet.

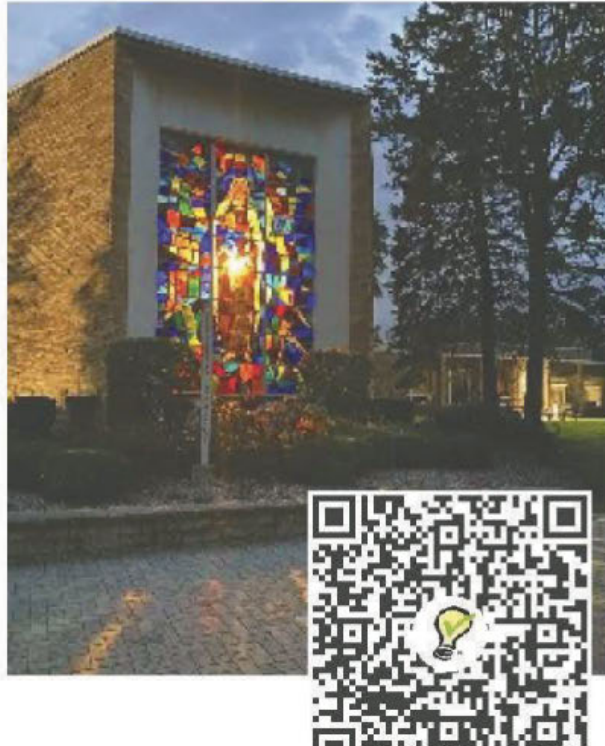

Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

Parishioners who donate electronically to the Sunday collection receive a quarterly envelope packet, which contains envelopes for any special collections (i.e. St. Vincent de Paul, Holy Day & Archdiocesan collections) rather than the full monthly packet you receive now. Providing you with this new quarterly packet results in a savings to the parish. **Thank you for your continued support of Prince of Peace!!**
