

### From the Pastor's Desk



Today we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Lent, "Laetare" Sunday. "Laetare" is Latin for "Rejoice." This Sunday is more joyful than the rest of the Sundays of Lent because we are celebrating the fact that we are half way along our yearly pilgrimage to Easter Sunday. But, in reality, good Christians should always feel joyful, even when they are fasting or doing acts of penance.

In the Gospel Reading today, Saint John explains to us the true cause of so much sadness and sin in the world. He tells us that even though Our Lord, Jesus Christ, Light of the World, came to the world, humanity preferred the darkness instead of the light. Even today, many people are afraid of the light, they turn their backs on God, they sin and act as if God did not exist. They prefer the darkness.

We know that the Holy Mass (Eucharist) is the summit of our faith. The problem is that many of these same people, since they live in darkness, cannot see, cannot understand, that during the Holy Eucharist, Our Lord becomes really present among us. During our Liturgy, the Light of the World, shines out again in the darkness to show us the road we should follow so that we can receive that Light in our souls and in our hearts. We should show to the world the light received in the Eucharist. The light should shine in us so brightly that we should be the image of Christ for others.

Lent, even though it is a time for austerity, is also a time for authenticity. We know that there are many people in this world who will try to lure us away from our faith. Frequently, we have to make sacrifices when we are tempted to exchange our love of God for love of earthly things. These days of Lent place before us a dilemma. We have to choose between the light and darkness, between good and evil, between love of God and love of those earthly things that separate us from the true road to Christ. If we choose good, if we decide to follow Jesus, sacrificing those other things, we will win out in the long run.

Without a doubt, when we change our lives and choose the good, we become better persons. It could even be possible that when we show others, through our good works, that we live a joyful and pure life completely dedicated to doing good that we will influence family members and maybe even the rest of the community to do the same.

I wish you an enjoyable weekend and a truly blest and faith-filled Lent.



# Have You Considered eGiving for Your Sunday Contributions?

There is a "Donate" button on our parish website that you can use for your Sunday donations. This option takes you to the Give Central website, where you can sign up for a regular schedule of contributing that YOU set up. The schedule is completely up to you, and there are several frequency options including weekly, bi-weekly, monthly and quarterly.

You can also sign up for continued Electronic Giving for your Sunday Stewardship contributions through the parish, either by direct debit from your bank account or credit card, on a monthly or weekly basis. A form is available on our parish website or can be emailed/mailed to you at your request.

After signing up for electronic giving, never worry about conditions: forgetting your envelope again! It continues your support to Prince of Peace when you are out of town, on vacation or unable to attend Mass.

### Anointing of the Sick at All Masses Next Weekend

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will be offered at all Masses next weekend. By participating in this sacrament as a community it allows and encourages those to be anointed to feel the support of their families, friends, and parish family.

We are often asked the question, "Can I be anointed?" You may be anointed if you meet any <u>one</u> of the following conditions:

- Anyone who is seriously ill, temporarily ill, convalescing, or preparing for surgery
- Anyone who is chronically ill
- Anyone who is emotionally troubled
- Anyone suffering from mental illness
- Anyone suffering from any form of addiction
- The elderly, even if not suffering from an illness
- Anyone who has been previously anointed but whose condition has changed
- Seriously ill children who can understand the meaning of the sacrament
