**THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED:** Another decision was handed down by the Supreme Court this week that severely limits the rights of states to regulate the abortion procedure. Texas House Bill 2 attempted to place the same requirements on abortion clinics as are placed upon other medical clinics. For example, the bill would require that hallways be wide enough for a gurney to pass down the hall in the event that a patient needs to be transported rapidly to a hospital. HB2 mandated that abortion facilities adhere to ambulatory surgical center requirements common to most outpatient facilities, and it also required abortionists to have admitting privileges at a hospital within 30 miles of the abortion facility to be able to handle emergencies when something goes wrong....In a five to three ruling, the Supreme Court viewed the regulations as too restrictive. Once again we see that abortion is treated by the law in a manner very different than other medical procedures. Normal safeguards that apply to other medical procedures are exempted in the case of abortions. While we as Catholics do not believe that the direct killing of an unborn child is ever morally permissible, we do believe that women who seek this procedure should have the protection normally afforded to other surgical procedures. This case points out the importance of the next election. It is likely that the next administration will have the opportunity to appoint one or more justices to the Supreme Court. Once on the Supreme Court, a justice is usually removed only by advanced age or death. As Catholic voters, we need to consider carefully the consequences of our vote. We may wish that we had other choices in the election ahead, but we must look at both the short term and the long term consequences of how we vote. As a Church, we cannot favor one candidate or another. However, we are free to speak about issues and to encourage people to vote in a way that best upholds our moral values. We are bound, in conscience, to consider more than party affiliation or economic benefits for voting for one candidate or another.
