**THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED:** We are a week into Lent but there is still time to begin again if our first days of Lenten practice have not been all that we had hoped or intended. Above all, I would encourage focusing on efforts that will help you draw closer to the Lord. Reading of the Scriptures (perhaps the daily Mass readings) could be a very beneficial practice. One should begin by asking the Holy Spirit to use the words of the Scriptures to touch your heart. Reading the sacred texts should not be hasty. It is better to read a few verses rather than try to read too much in any one time of prayer. One suggestion is to read a passage once to get an overall awareness of the content. You might, in that first reading, make a mental note of words or phrases that stood out for you. In the next reading, be attuned to those words or phrases. Awareness of our feeling can be very helpful to us during prayer. At times, we may feel a sense of peace. At other times, it may be a resistance to certain things in the scripture. Then you might ask yourself what those words or phrases are prompting you to do or to change in your life. You could end the time by reading the passage again and then asking God to help you act upon the many actions that were suggested during your prayer time. It can also be beneficial to keep a spiritual journal or notebook recording the thoughts and feelings that you experience. Some people find it helpful to review what you have written from time to time. This can reveal a pattern to the way God is acting in your life. May the Holy Spirit touch your heart through the word of God!
