**THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED:** Desire--What do I desire? Our desires drive our thoughts and our actions. Are my desires focused on things that will perish or will eventually be taken away from me? Jesus would have us desire things that will endure for all eternity. In the end, it will be these things that will bring us lasting happiness. Things that cannot last are unable to bring us the happiness for which we long. Sharing in God's life will last forever; it will bring us true happiness. Ask God to make a sharing in His life to be the most intense desire of your heart.

PROTECTING GOD'S (HILDREN: On April 29, there will be a Protecting God's Children Session explicitly organized for the members of the three parishes of Meade County. The immediate impetus for requesting the diocese to provide this training was the awareness that we were struggling to find people who could provide babysitting services for the participants of the ALPHA program. However, we frequently struggle to find people who have completed the required training to assist in the Religious Education Program or to provide transportation to children or teenagers to various events. This is training that could profit every adult in our parish communities. Teachers, daycare workers and grandparents could benefit from this training in that it could help them recognize children in danger of abuse. The more we are aware of the signs that children are being abused, the more quickly we can give our children the protection they need. Even if someone never plans to be part of the religious education program, I am asking you to attend this session or a session that will be provided somewhere in this area in the future. It is easy to complain or to judge those who abuse our children, but we all have an obligation to do everything we can to protect them. Studies show that it is usually a family member someone that is trusted by the family that is responsible for the abuse. We must be alert to prevent harm to our children. The session will be at 2:00 p.m. on the 29<sup>th</sup> in Meade.
