THOUGHTS FROM FATHER TED: I have spent a number of weeks reflecting on various aspects of the virtue of chastity. I would like to transition to another important topic for the present time. In my recent letter to all parishioners concerning the revelations of sexual misconduct on the part of clergy, I suggested that our best response is to live our faith more fully. This involves a stronger commitment to prayer and a more intense turning to the Sacraments, especially the Sacrament of Penance and the Eucharist. The Sacrament of Penance manifests in a concrete form the mercy of God. It calls us to acknowledge the sin that has touched our lives, to repent and to seek God's mercy. The more we are aware of our sinfulness and are striving to remove sin from our lives, the more fruitful the Eucharist can be for us. While few people look forward to the confessing of sins, the experience can be liberating. It helps us put past failures behind us and gives us the grace to begin anew.
