

"Our Scriptures, celebrate Christ coming in history two millennia ago, his coming into our present lives and needs, and his future advent when God's plan for our salvation reaches its fullness," the sourcebook announces. For reference, we enter Year C of the Church year of the Sunday cycle highlighting the Gospel of Luke and Year II of the daily Mass lectionary in the year of Our Lord 2022. What is coming, we have heard before, but is always new in the Lord's coming into our present lives, our present moment, our present circumstances and as we look to his coming in glory.

Starting our new Church year, I have only recently realized that though Fr.
