MUSINGS OF FATHER JIM: Dear people of the light,

It appears that Candlemas, February 2nd, the celebration of the Presentation of Our Lord in the Temple, the day of prayer for consecrated religious, will fall on a snow day this year. Eleven years ago, Bishop John was ordained in the Cathedral at Dodge City on an extremely cold, windy, and icy day on this Feast Day. St. John Paul II established the World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life in 1997 to be celebrated in conjunction with the feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas Day, which highlights the fact that Christ is the light of the world through the symbolic lighting of candles. "Similarly, consecrated men and women are called to spread the light and love of Jesus Christ through their unique witness of selfless service, such as caring for the poor, the contemplative work of prayer, or through their professional careers." It is quite natural to bring these two things together, the presentation of the child Jesus at the Temple and the consecration to the Religious life by men and women of our age.

A parent told me that their children were praying for another snow day. I don't remember a day like in December, when the schools were given a "wind" day of staying safely in the home, but the modern prognostic ability to predict storms allows for the reasonable practice of cancelling the scheduled activities of the day in respect of the inclement weather. A snow day always seemed like a gift of freedom as a child, yet cancelling is always unsettling to me, a person very dependent on routine, to carry out my ministry is hindered when events are cancelled. Consecrated religious have a sense that their calling is never being put on hold or postponed. Consecrated Religious have made a visible and outward sign of the constancy of God's love. Yes, God does give the Sabbath, but even the Lord healed on the Sabbath.

I will have blessed candles on Wednesday at the Mass at St. Anthony, a symbolic gesture that allows the bees wax candles we use in the church to give the spiritual light for which they are intended. We continue to pray that Bishop John will be exonerated and return to serve the diocese. The end of the investigation seems mysteriously slow in coming to a conclusion. February 8th will mark one year anniversary of the public announcement and the message of Bishop John, to which he has firmly held, that he will make no other public statement until the conclusion of the investigation. Bishop Vincke of Salina has been very gracious in the administration of the diocese, but all are hoping soon to the return of the light of apostolic witness in our local church.

Though not technically a consecrated religious, it is very appropriate that we add Bishop John to our worldwide prayer for all those who are consecrated in the religious life, as he was ordained a Bishop on this very Feast, and his light came into our temple of worship. Also, I, being a professed member of the Secular Franciscans, need your prayers. "God our Father, we thank you for calling men and women to serve in your Son's Kingdom as sisters, brothers, religious priests, consecrated virgins, and hermits, as well as members of Secular Institutes. Renew their knowledge and love of you, and send your Holy Spirit to help them respond generously and courageously to your will. We ask this through our Lord Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen." Saints Simeon and Anna, pray for us! Fr. Jim
